

Community Colleges are the only part of state government controlled by locally elected representatives.








Prop 98 Guaranteed Minimum Funding for K-14





Cabot-Las Positas Property Tax Rate




Seven Trustee Districts


Each trustee district *should* have an election **every 4 years.**
