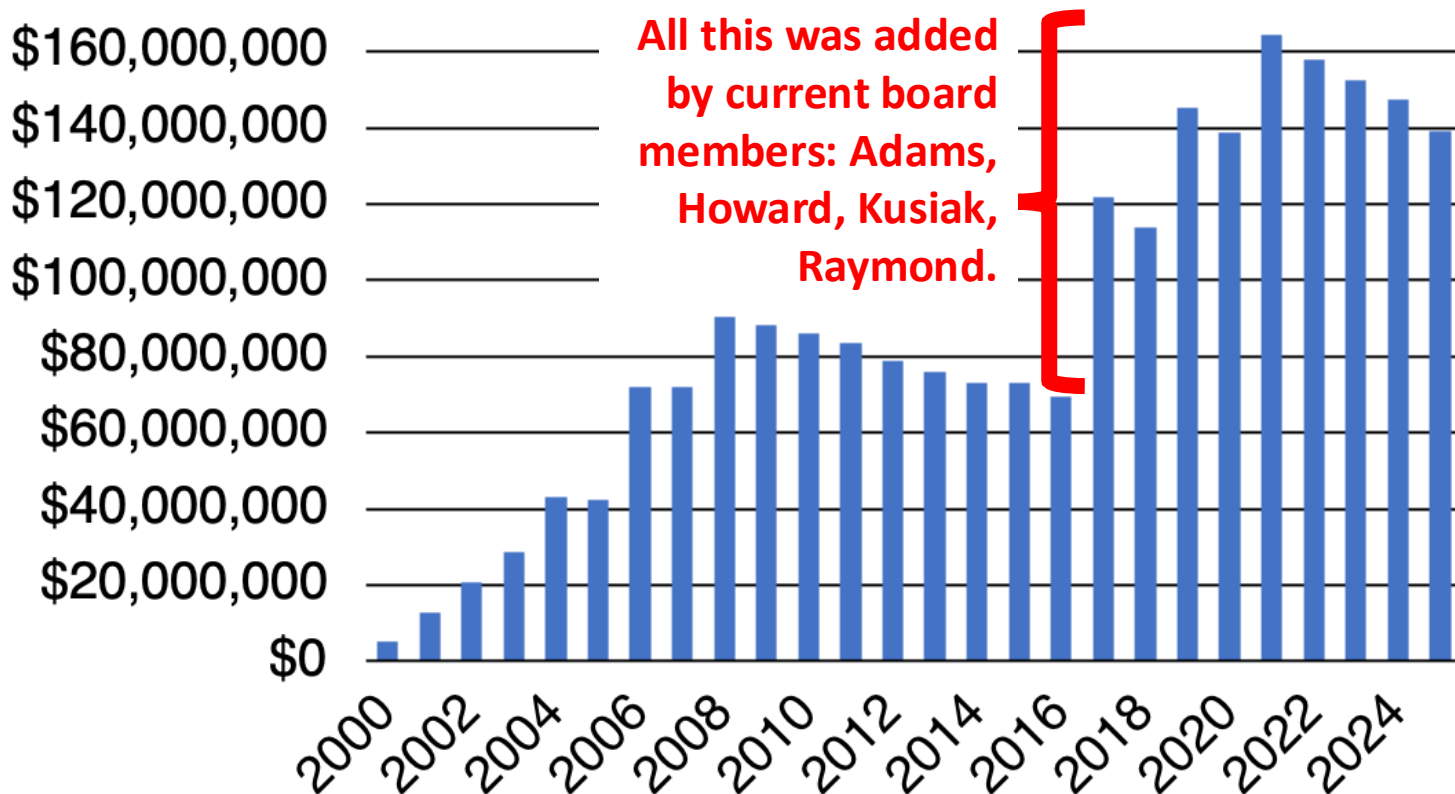


Please Elect Joseph Grcar “Mr. frugal” for Castro Valley School Board this November
