QST, QST, this is _____ (**call ONLY**). The Fresno county ARES® net will begin in 5 Minutes. All licensed amateurs are welcome, and encouraged to check in. This is _____ (**call ONLY**) standing by for net.

At 1930 hrs

QST, QST, this is _____ (**call ONLY**), your net control station for this evening. Welcome to the Fresno County ARES® weekly emergency communications net. This net can be interrupted at any time for emergency or priority traffic. Is there any emergency or priority traffic? If so, please come now.

(Handle traffic or acknowledge nothing heard.)

This net is held every Monday at 1930 local, on the KJ6OUG repeater, 147.150 MHz with a positive offset and a tone of 141.3. Our alternate repeater is 146.940 with a negative offset and tone of 141.3 In the event of a complete repeater failure, the net will be conducted on 147.150 simplex.

This is a directed net so all traffic or comments shall be directed through net control. Please do not break without permission from net control unless you have emergency or priority traffic.

The purpose of the net is to exchange announcements, news, training and pertinent information pertaining to ARES®/RACES and other groups interested in emergency communications in the greater Fresno area.

Non-emergency related traffic will be accepted after the net is closed. Members wishing to use the frequency for such traffic are encouraged to remain on frequency after net control closes the net.
