# VOICES OF WHITAKER

Voices of Whitaker has begun a new year! Over 100 students have signed up to participate in grades 3-6. For our first concert (Thursday, Dec. 5 at the Performing Arts Center, High School Campus), all grades will join together to sing holiday favorites such as "Santa's Going On A Diet" and "The Reindeer Hop". On the last day of school, Friday Dec. 20<sup>th</sup>, the Voices of Whitaker will be singing at the Union Terminal Museum Center Rotunda from 11:00-11:30am. This will be followed by a sack lunch and free admission for the students to the Duke Energy Train Display! At least 24 adult chaperones will be needed for the Dec. 20<sup>th</sup> field trip (Museum Center requires at least 1 adult per every 5 children in grades 5 and under).

NEW THIS YEAR: All chaperones will need to be fingerprinted at the Finneytown Board of Education office before chaperoning field trips. Many school districts already have this policy in place to make sure that all children are safe and in good hands. Please call Patti Schnur (728-3700) to schedule an appointment for your fingerprinting. It just takes a few minutes, and the school will cover the cost!

Looking ahead to the future: Ms. Johnson would like to request some help with writing and applying for grants to fund a new music keyboard/computer lab to be located in the general music area. Many students have expressed an interest in learning how to play piano and the piano is one of Ms. Johnson's interests as well. In addition, synth. keyboards attached to computers with music software would open up new avenues of music education for all students of Whitaker Elementary! 
