Meeting called to order at 7:02 by April Bruder.

Angela Hursh – Citizens for Finneytown Schools Chairperson (PAC)

7.69 million for two building for FLSD. We have a website - finneytownbond.org

Why? 1) Repairs, 1 millions/ year on repairs. 2) Technology, not enough electrical outlets in classrooms to keep up with computer technology. 3) Security Issue – 68 doors in all there buildings = security nightmare.

Bond issue – The cost is an assessed value of your house. \$100,000 assessed value = \$22/ month The bond we are currently paying off is 5.0 or 5.5 mills on in 5 years. 13 mills in taxes for 5 years, resulting in 7.6 mills.

The state has offered us 60% but we have to come up with the 40% first. All numbers are on website FAQ page. Absentee ballots with save the campaign money. Need \$5,000 - \$10,000 raised to run the campaign. Architectural rendering of buildings will soon be available. Talking points are available to convince neighbors.
