Congratulations to Ken Bouman! In addition to an academic scholarship, Valparaiso University has awarded Ken the Forte Music Scholarship for tuba performance. ## New Kroger Card Earnings Program

Kroger is ending their fixed-rate Kroger Card reward program as of April 30th. In its place, Kroger is introducing a new program beginning May 1st that will track spending by using your Kroger Plus Card where proceeds will be determined according to what other groups are spending.

Thanks to our record-keeping, Finneytown Secondary PTA is very confident that we can continue this tradition of using the new Kroger Plus card program to raise funds for band camp, school trips as well as PTA while also supporting the entire school community. Be assured that PTA will continue to accrue funds with the current cards until April 30th. Anything loaded after April 30 will not go toward your current account!! You only have until April 30 to load funds and earn the $4 \%$.

Although we are unable to determine exactly what the earnings will be after May 1st for individual families since the fixed rate no longer applies, we hope that you will continue supporting PTA by signing up when the times comes. After we have completed the application process, we will notify the entire school community about the new procedure and specific details which will require a simple online sign up directly through Kroger Plus. No more purchasing and reloading your cards!! All that is required is a simple designation of "Finneytown Secondary PTA" as the recipient. We will also streamline the process as we have done in the past by providing a form to complete quarterly statements to designate trip, camp, or both.

We will keep you apprised of this new process and notify you when the registration is complete and you can begin registering your plus cards.
