



This **zoom meeting** was called to order by President Keith Stevens at 9:06 AM

Minutes of the February 6 SCCA meeting were unanimously approved on motion of Mike Gormley and second by Ralph Peacock.

Treasurer Mike Gormley reported an available bank balance of \$2,287.31. (Complete report available on SCCA website www.sccafl.com.)

Executive committee report: Included recommendations that dues be set at \$10 for renewals and \$25 for new members for the coming fiscal year, recommended that the current slate of officers be nominated for another term, tentatively set the meeting schedule for the next two year and that Zoom be the vehicle for most of the meetings.

Unfinished Business: Member Bob Ormsbee has indicated he will renew his membership after a leave of absence. At the request of Wells Fargo Bank Treasurer Mike Gormley was appointed key executive for the SCCA. It apparently fills the need of the bank for bank account details.

New Business: Bob Stern moved and Dave Muller seconded a motion to set dues for the next fiscal year at \$10 for renewals and \$25 for new members. Motion passed unanimously.

Officers: The executive committee nominated Keith Stevens for president, Ed Richey for Vice President, Mike Gormley for Treasurer, and Sam Dunn for Secretary. There were no other nominations. The election will be conducted at the April meeting.

Meetings: Members expressed agreement that future meetings be conducted by the Zoom platform and asked the exec committee to investigate the possibility of one in-person meeting such as a picnic at the end of the fiscal year. The exec committee will comply.

Meeting dates for the future two years will be posted on the SCCA website. Meeting will be first Saturdays with the exception of January and February 2022. Due to conflicts those meeting will be on the second Saturday morning.

The business meeting was adjourned. The members participated in a caller workshop explaining how to “fix” an asymmetrical square. Keith Stevens presented the formula for correction and several members practices the procedure on the Zoom platform with screen sharing. The meeting concluded at 10:16 am.
