Attached you will find correspondence from ADEQ (Arizona Department of Environmental Quality). A records request from ADEQ shows an <u>Air Quality Field Inspection Report for Asphalt, Paving and Supply occurring 11/7/23 (Inspection report No: 434642).</u> On 11/29/23, Notice of Violation (Case ID #216557) was mailed to Asphalt, Paving & Supply, Inc.

On 1/29/2024, a Consent Order (Docket No. A-02-24) was signed stating that "By June 28, 2024, the ordered baghouse must be received, installed and operational. Asphalt Paving and Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials has agreed to notify ADEQ <u>is</u> the manufacturer delivery date has been delayed."

"On February 28, 2024, Fain Signature Group released drone footage of the proposed Government Tank Quarry site for public consumption." This is the proposed rock and gravel location. In the description for the video, "The video has been provided to allow the general public to view the remote site being zoned and the surrounding area." Notice it says "being zoned," not rezoned. What is a Government Tank Quarry? I don't find the definition on the internet and the name is not from the ADEQ.

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

This Notice of Violation (NOV) is an informal compliance assurance tool used by the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) to put a responsible party (such as a facility owner or operator) on notice that the Department alleges a significant violation of an environmental requirement has occurred and this notice describes the facts known to ADEQ at the time of issuance. ADEQ has reason to believe that Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. as the owner/operator of equipment located at 165228 Physical Property For Air Portable Location has violated a requirement of the Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.), a rule within the Arizona Administrative Code (A.A.C.), or an applicable permit, license, or administrative order. ADEQ identified the violations alleged below during an inspection or file review completed on November 07, 2023. See the Evidence of Compliance section below for the actions necessary to demonstrate resolution of the alleged violation(s).

ADEQ reserves the right to take a formal enforcement action, such as issuing an administrative order or filing a civil lawsuit, regardless of whether the Department has issued an NOV. Neither ADEQ's issuance of an NOV nor its failure to do so precludes the Department from pursuing these remedies. However, the timeliness of a complete response to this notice will be considered by ADEQ in determining if and how to pursue such remedies.

If this NOV is a result of an inspection then the NOV also serves as a monthly status update as required by A.R.S. § 41-1009(J).

J. LEGAL AUTHORITY and NATURE OF ALLEGED VIOLATION(S)

Permit 69486 - Attachment "B" Condition III.A.

"The Permittee shall not operate a co-located concrete batch plant with a truck mix product loading operation without operating a baghouse to control emissions at the product loading point. [A.A.C. R18-2-306.01 and -331.A.3.a]"

On November 7, 2023, during an on-site inspection of Asphalt Paving Supply, the ADEQ staff observed the permitted Hot Mix plant and documented the truck mix loadout operation was not equipped with a required baghouse or dust collector.

Permit 69486 - Attachment "A" Condition IV. D.

"All equipment covered by this General Permit shall be clearly marked with a serial number or other equipment number that is listed on the ATO for that piece of equipment." During the inspection ADEQ Air Compliance Staff observed and documented a Concrete Batch Plant that was not listed in the equipment list of the ATO or Permit documents issued on June 24, 2022.

II. EVIDENCE OF COMPLIANCE

- Within 14 calendar days of receipt of this Notice, please submit a statement on whether you will proceed with the option to operate a baghouse at the point of truck mix loadout or the option to request a permit change. This statement must be signed by the designated Responsible Official for the facility. Please note that failure to adhere to the deadlines outlined in this NOV may be grounds for escalation to formal enforcement and potentially revocation of your current permit by ADEQ.
- Within 30 calendar days of receipt of this Notice, please submit a purchase order documenting the purchase of a baghouse for use on controlling emissions from the truck mix loadout operation.
- Within 90 calendar days of receipt of this Notice, please submit evidence that the baghouse
 was received, installed, and operational. Please submit documentation that includes a photo
 of the baghouse and certification letter signed by the designated Responsible Official for the
 facility.
- 4. Within 97 calendar days of receipt of this Notice, please submit modifications through the myDEQ portal of the Authorization to Operate (ATO) to reflect the "Concrete Batch Plant with Baghouse" on the equipment list.

Comments:

While fueling at the Prescott Valley ADEQ fueling station the ADEQ inspectors observed visible emissions (VE) from equipment and operations near the Asphalt Paving & Supply (AP&S) hot mix asphalt (HMA) and concrete batch plants (CBP). As the inspectors completed fueling, the VE near the hot plant dissipated, the VE from the concrete batch plant continued. The ADOT fueling station is elevated above the HMA & perations and the sun angle from the fueling station is incorrect for a visible emission observation.

The ADEQ inspectors drove down to the AP&S office and entered the building and met the receptionist. The ADEQ inspectors requested to speak with Chris Mathern, Materials Manager. The receptionist contacted Mr. Mathern and notified him that ADEQ was in the building. The receptionist informed the ADEQ inspectors Mr. Mathern was on his way. A few minutes later, Mr. Mathern and Ben Dilcher, Project Superintendent arrived and introduced themselves to the ADEQ inspectors. The ADEQ inspectors introduced themselves also, Rob Verville, Cameron Collins and Jean Ziga.

The ADEQ inspectors conducted an in-briefing and explained observing the VE from the ADOT fueling station. The group walked out to the parking lot and observed the CBP. The VE was continuing and the ADEQ inspector collected photographs of the CBP and VE. The ADEQ inspector observed the CBP truck loadout did not have a dust collector/baghouse or shroud around the truck loadout area. After observing the operations and collecting photographs, the group retreated into a conference room. The Notice of Inspection was presented to and signed by Mr. Mathern. The ADEQ inspectors inquired if the CBP had a dust collector/baghouse. Mr. Mathern stated the CBP did not have a dust collector/baghouse. The group had a discussion regarding the permit requirement for a dust collector/baghouse on the CBP. Mr. Mathern stated her was unaware of the dust collector/baghouse requirement. A discussion ensued regarding the previous environmental manager whom passed away. Mr. Dilcher stated he was given myDEQ rights by the Primary Responsible Official (PRO). Mr. Mathern stated himself and Mr. Dilcher are carrying the environmental load.

ADEQ discussed and explained the process for compliance, an inspection report would be provided to the facility, a Notice would also be prepared and issued to the facility for no dust collector/baghouse. Ms. Ziga explained the Consent Order process for ADEQ and AP&S to enter into a legally binding agreement that spells out the compliance conditions and timeframes. The ADEQ inspectors left the facility.

After the inspection, Ms. Ziga conducted a myDEQ database search and determined the facility does not have a concrete batch plant on its air quality permit #: 69486.

A database review located ATO: 125350, dated 10/6/2020, lists two concrete batch plants, capacity 85 cubic yards per hour, flyash and cement, both units with Serial/ID: c6394p. Annual operating hours 1506.5. Email contact: cgraff@nicnd.com

ATO: 128170, Hot Mix Asphalt Plant GP Renewal, dated 6/24/2022, lists no concrete batch plant. A water heater possibly associated with the batch plant is on the equipment list, Serial/ID: c6394p. Annual operating Hours 3964.0. Email contact: cgraff@nicnd.com

The email contact for both ATOs is Chris Graff, Environmental Manager that passed away.

Exit Debrief:

- Excessive dust was observed coming from the concrete batch plant.
- The concrete batch plant is not equipped with a baghouse.
- The Concrete Batch Plant is not listed in the facility's current permit,







I. RECITALS

- A. Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials is the operator of the Hot Mix Asphalt General Permit Plant, located at 2400 N Glassford Hill Rd, Prescott Valley, AZ 86314 in Yavapai County.
- B. Pete Thompson is a representative of Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials and certifies that he is fully authorized to execute this Consent Order on behalf of Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials and to legally bind Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials to this Consent Order.
- C. The Director of Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has jurisdiction of this action's subject matter and is authorized to issue this Consent Order pursuant to the Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) § 49-461, § 41-1004, and § 41-1092.07(F)(5).
- D. Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials agrees that the Director of ADEQ has jurisdiction of this action's subject matter.
- E. This Consent Order contains the full terms of the agreement between Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials and ADEQ.
- F. Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials voluntarily agrees to this Consent Order based only on the terms contained in the Consent Order.
- G. Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials understands that agreeing to this Consent Order does not resolve any liability that it may have for civil penalties for a violation of any State or Federal environmental law.







- H. Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials understands that agreeing to this Consent Order does not mean it admits to any civil or criminal liability, or waives any right or assertion of any defense available to Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials under applicable law.
- Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials does not admit the validity of any Agency Determinations and Findings contained in this Consent Order.
- J. Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials agrees not to dispute the validity or terms of this Consent Order in any future proceeding to enforce the terms of this Consent Order.
- K. Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials retains the right to dispute the validity of any Agency Determinations and Findings contained in this Consent Order in any proceeding other than a proceeding to enforce the terms of this Consent Order.

II. AGENCY DETERMINATIONS AND FINDINGS

The Director makes the following Agency Determinations and Findings that Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials has violated requirements of ADEQ issued Air Quality Control Permit No.69486.

- A. Attachment "B", Condition III.A.3: Facility Wide Requirements [A.A.C. R18-2-306.01 and -331.A.3.a] [Material Permit Condition]:
 - The Permittee shall not operate a co-located concrete batch plant with a truck mix product loading operation without operating a baghouse to control emissions at the product loading point.
- B. On November 7, 2023, ADEQ conducted an air quality inspection for Asphalt Paving & Supply DBA Arrowhead Materials located at 2425 N Glassford Hill Rd, in Prescott Valley, Arizona. The facility operates a Concrete Batch Plant with a truck mix process that is not vented to any pollution control equipment as required by their general permit.
- C. On November 29, 2023, ADEQ issued NOV Case 216557 to Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials requiring the company to install and operate a baghouse, also known as a dust collector, at the product loading point for the truck mix concrete batch plant within 90 calendar days of receipt of the Notice.
- D. Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials confirmed NOV issuance on



November 29, 2023, and thus established the deadline to operate a baghouse on February 27, 2024.

- E. On December 1, 2023, Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials responded to ADEQ provided a proof of purchase documentation for the baghouse with an expected delivery date of June 18th, 2024. Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials requested additional time to acquire and operate the baghouse at the point of truckload mix.
- F. On December 11, 2023, to assess compliance with the NAAQS, ADEQ completed an air modeling analysis for Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials to establish interim maximum daily throughput limits that will protect the particulate matter (PM) ambient air quality standards.

III. COMPLIANCE SCHEDULE

ADEQ has established the compliance requirements. ADEQ and Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials have agreed on the completion deadlines. Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials agrees to comply with the provisions of this Consent Order as follows:

- A. Except for the condition identified in Section II, A of this order, and Asphalt Paving & Supply DBA Arrowhead Materials shall comply with the requirements for its Concrete Batch Plant, Crushing & Screening Plant, and the Hot Mix Asphalt Plant.
- B. Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials shall comply with the following operational requirements until the termination of the Consent Order:
 - a. Concrete Batch Plant production shall be limited to 400 cubic yards per day
 - b. Crushing and Screening Plant production shall be limited to 3,250 tons per day
 - c. Hot Mix Asphalt Plant production shall be limited to 3,500 tons per day
 - d. Maintain daily production records for each day of operation for the Concrete Batch Plant, the Crushing and Screening plant, and the Hot Mix Asphalt.
 - e. The above production records shall be made available to ADEQ upon request.
- C. By June 28, 2024, the ordered baghouse must be received, installed, and operational. Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials has agreed to notify ADEQ is the manufacturer delivery date has been delayed. Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials shall submit to ADEQ, documentation showing the control

- equipment, including photos and certification by the designated Responsible Comporate Official for the facility.
- D. Within 7 days of completing requirement III.C above (equipment is installed and operational). Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials shall update its Authorization To Operate (ATO) through myDEQ. Please Add/Delete Mosify equipment as necessary to ensure that all required equipment is included and accurately reflected. Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials shall multiy ADEQ upon completion of this condition.

IV. STATUS REPORTS

- A. Until this Consent Order is terminated. Aspiralt Paving & Supply. Inc. DBA Acrowing at Materials agrees to submit a written status report to ADEQ by the Materials of every month, beginning the first month following the effective date of this Consent Order. Each written status report shall be for the previous calendar month and shall identify the status of each item in Section III of this Consent Order.
- B. ADEQ will review the status reports and inform Aspiralt Paving & Supply, Inc. DEA. Arrowhead Materials in writing of any disputes. Aspiralt Paving & Supply, Inc. DEA. Arrowhead Materials must incorporate all required modifications, changes or other alterations that ADEQ requests within a reasonable time specified by ADEQ.

V. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS

- A. This Consent Order does not include issues regarding releases, contamination, sources, operations, facilities or processes not expressly stated by the terms of this Consent Order, and does not interfere with the rights that the State of Arizona or Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials have under any federal or Arizona environmental statutes and rules regarding such issues.
- B. This Consent Order is not a permit of any kind, does not modify any permit of any kind, nor is it an agreement to issue a permit of any kind under federal, state or local law.
- C. This Consent Order does not alter, modify or revoke federal, state, or local law.
- D. This Consent Order is not a defense to any action to enforce any such permits or laws.
- E. Asphalt Paving & Supply, Inc. DBA Arrowhead Materials has an obligation to:
 - Apply for, obtain, and comply with all applicable permits.
 - Comply with federal, state or local laws.
 - Comply with the terms of this Consent Order.



VI. SITE ACCESS
