4. Prayer for Joanne Schmeling.

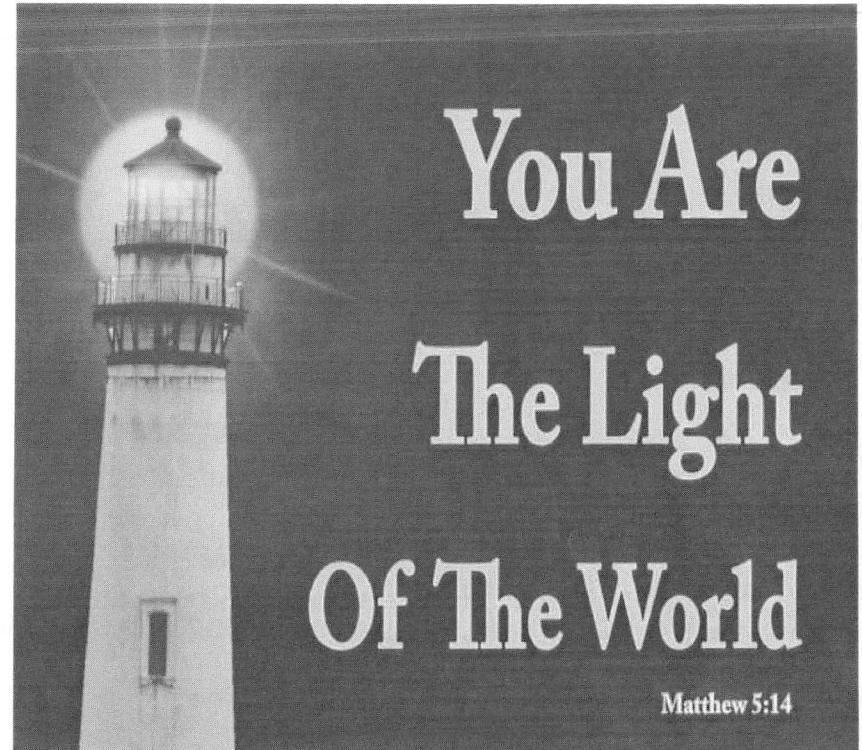
Please continue to pray for Joanne Schmeling as she recovers from heart bypass surgery. We pray for steady healing and renewed strength for her in the days ahead.
