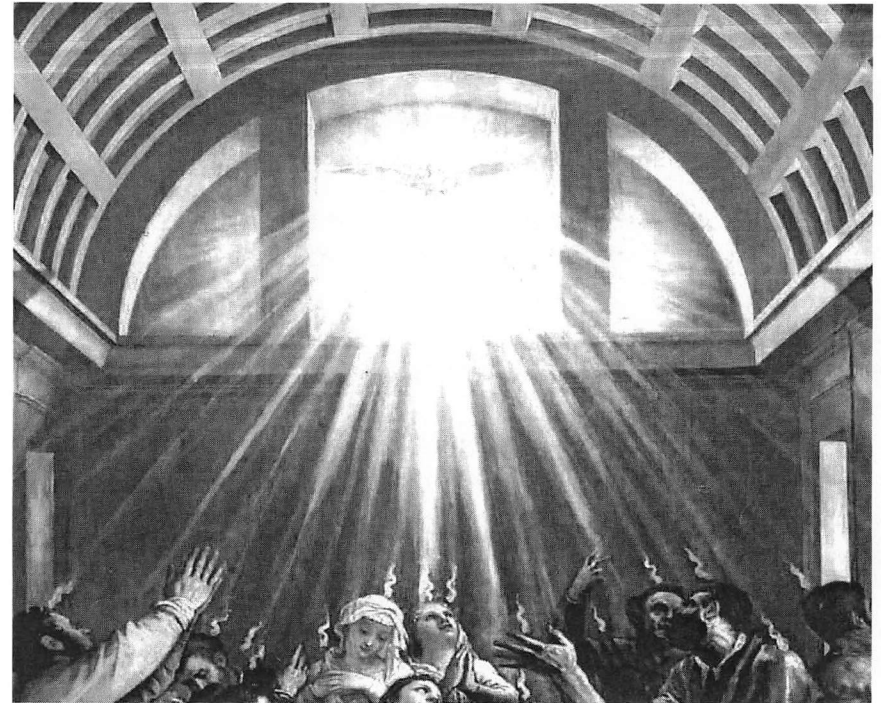
3. Oasis Bible Study This Week (May 27)
