

Trans-Light-Element Adventure Series Description and Overview

In <u>Episode 1</u>, the audience is introduced to the Reuel family. They live in a middle-income suburb near Denver, Colorado. Benjamin Franklin Reuel is 16 years old. His older sister, Vanessa, is 18. His little brother, Joseph, is 4. Ben's mother, Rachel, is a devoted mother and home maker. His father is Dr. Gamiel Reuel, a research scientist and professor at the University of Denver. Ben has worked with his father in his research since he was old enough to walk. He helped his dad build their backyard hobby laboratory where they spend a lot of time together.

Years before Ben was born, Dr. Reuel began experimenting with Unified Field, an old theory first proposed by Scottish physicist, James Clerk Maxwell, and later championed by Albert Einstein. One day, Gamiel is working alone in the lab when energy field critical configuration ratios accidentally fall in sync, catching Dr. Reuel by surprise. Ben arrives just in time to save his dad from certain disaster.

As Ben helps his father pick up the pieces, they discover an incredible new side effect -a new elementary substance Ben names "Trans-Light-Element" (T-L-E for short.) When others learn about their discovery, unknown power brokers conspire to threaten Dr. Reuel's family.

Meanwhile, an internal family crisis shakes Ben's world to the core. He learns his little brother has a life-threatening disease. The family needs a place to go where their new enemies can't find them. They also need to find a good doctor who can help Joseph.
