1. Held our Annual Meeting
2. Fixed radiators in the Sacristy, Greg's office and disconnected the leaking heater in the basement

14. Replaced the Light Bulbs in the Parish Hall with brighter bulbs.
15. Deep cleaned the kitchen and the exhaust fan.
16. New seasonal advertisements to our Marquee and entrance signs for Holy Week
17. Agape' Dinner on Maundy Thursday.
18. Had the bowl of our Silver Chalice electroplated in gold.
19. Replaced the Church Roof completely at a total cost of \$234,685.20 of which Trinity paid a \$1,000 deductible and \$26,000 for the portion of the roof not covered by insurance. Church Insurance paid \$207,685.20. It is magnificent
20. Due to damage caused by the roof repair crews, we were able to repair the parking lot holes
21. Installed three flood lights in the Parking Lot.
22. Replaced our outside Trinity Parish Signs.
23. Bishop Jeffry Lee visited Trinity in June. This is his last visit here as he is retiring in 2020.
24. Installed a new ADA approved railing from the parking lot to the Parish Hall door. Decorated it to discourage bicycle parking.
25. Upgraded the lighting in the Parish Hall with brighter bulbs.
26. Extended the railing at the top of the stairs from the parking lot for easier access.
27. Installed a grab bar by the toilet in the Parish Hall.
28. Hung new exterior banners, one by the parking lot entrance and one at the corner of Benton and Lincoln.
29. Repaired the rotten window sill in the Guild Room.
30. We joined the competition of the Saint's March Madness Tournament and learned a lot about our Saints. The Winner? Martha of Bethany!
31. We painted rocks with Jesus' love and hid them all over Aurora
32. The St. Margaret's Quilt Raffle was a smashing success with proceeds supporting Aurora's Mutual Ground Program.
