INFO

Our program is evolving, and we are excited.

In the last 3-4 years, our travel demand has grown exponentially.

From clinics across the country and internationally, to presenting at horse expos and entertaining in night shows, and competing—we've been busy, and we aren't finished yet!

Our program has shifted to focusing on seasonal colt starting, educating young horses, offering select sale horses, and training Liberty horses.

Usually, we are available to take in customer horses November - February/March, and again May-ish - August/early September-ish.

During these months, we sometimes have room for an already started horse that has a discipline focus—i.e. an already educated riding horse needing a “tune up”.

Older horses that are not started, or need help with troubleshooting an existing issue are on a case-by-case basis. We are not always home consistently to dedicate the time to helping those horses and in that event, we do have a couple of good friends who are horsemen that we can recommend to you.

Horses in our program are kept outside as much as possible. We also recommend keeping youngsters with other horses of their same age and sex.



TRAINING

BY THE WEEK **\$500 every 7-days**

Short-term evaluations are what this option is meant for.

i.e. Horses that you might want to get an estimation of how long training a maneuver, or training in general, or modifying behavior would take.



TRAINING

BY THE MONTH **\$1800 every 30-days**

Typically meant for young horses that will go into a discipline-specific or all-around training program once they're ready —OR— horses already started needing a tune up or refinement. This is also the option for Liberty Horses.





TRAINING

FOR A TROUBLED HORSE, OR
AN AGED NOT STARTED, OR A FERAL HORSE

Contact for pricing, base price is \$2500 every 30-days

ex: A aged horse that training has been started and/or attempted and maybe it was only halter broke, or excessively bucks, runs off, rears - AND/OR- an aged horse that came out of a situation where he/she has not been educated for life as a domesticated horse (not halter broke, not started under saddle, unhandled, feral/wild, etc).

This option has limited openings due to our travel schedule.

We suggest that, if at all possible, the horse receive a veterinary evaluation stating that the horse is sound to begin training.

Experience has taught us that in these cases, horses could typically due with consistent physical rehabilitation and veterinary care before a trainer can get much education and training accomplished.





MORE DETAILS

All rates listed includes board, training 5-6 days/week, monthly update video, scheduled visits/lessons for the owner during the duration of training.

Once we get at least a week of handling on the horse, we will be in touch to set up your first visit/lesson. We set aside time each week to type up a quick training update that one of us will then send to you.

From here, send us an email at info@versatilehorses.com and we will send over a contract and information to finalize your horse's training spot and pay your deposit that goes towards the initial training bill.
