

Scout Conduct Commitment

I agree to the following:

I will behave in accordance to the Scout Law and Oath. I will follow the Scout Outdoor Code and practice Leave No Trace at all times. A scout is trustworthy, loyal, helpful, friendly, courteous, kind, obedient, cheerful, thrifty, brave, clean and reverent.

I will follow instructions given to me by an adult or junior leader to do or not do something.

I will not use verbal or physical threats or intimidation to other scouts or adults.

I will not use unnecessary or inappropriate physical behavior or contact.

I will set a good example by keeping myself appropriately dressed and clean.

I will not use language to offend or degrade another, including derogatory, foul or profane language.

I will not exhibit behavior that is disrespectful or damaging to any other person or personal property. I will not cause any type of property damage to natural or man-made areas or to the environment in general.

I will not have possession or use of fireworks or other similar devices. I will not have any unauthorized and/or unsupervised use or possession of firearms or other weapons.

I will not use or possession of alcoholic beverages, tobacco or controlled substances (except medication of which the adult leadership has been made aware.)

I will be responsible in caring for troop equipment and I understand I am responsible for any loss or damage that I may cause. I will respect the property of others and will not steal or damage property that does not belong to me.

I will work cooperatively in my patrol and troop to share in the work.

I will bring to the attention of a leader or the SPL any situations that make me uncomfortable and will not take matters into my own hands.

I will not do anything that intentionally causes danger to myself or others.

I will not leaving designated areas without Scoutmaster's permission. I understand this as I will not to an area other than that requested and I will not entering property marked "No Trespassing."

I understand that if I do not follow the rules outlined above that a call will be placed to my parents and my parents will immediately remove me from an event. A meeting will then take place between myself, my parents and the appropriate troop personnel to discuss my future behavior and continuance as a member of the troop.
