The purpose of the pancake brunch is three-fold: to raise awareness to the needs of the less fortunate in our communities; to increase volunteerism and to educate the community to the opportunities to serve; and to raise funds to help support organizations that serve the needy. We are accredited by the Better Business Bureau and 100% of all ticket sales go directly to the needy.

This year over 24 sites will be involved in Dayton, Cincinnati, and Springfield. Over the past 30 years the Day of Caring has raised over \$850,000 for the needy. The Foodbank and the Emergency Housing Coalition are just a few of the organizations supported by the Day of Caring efforts. But we cannot do this alone. Your support and the support of your congregation are vital. Please join us this year in showing that we care.
