WE ARE GRATEFUL TO BE PART OF A COMMUNITY OF BELIEVERS WHO SHARE THE VISION AND WHO ARE COMMITTED TO MAKING A POSITIVE DIFFERENCE IN THE WORLD.

A GREAT BIG THANK YOU TO EVERYONE WHO SUPPLIED EASTER BASKETS THAT WE ARE DISTRIBUTED TO THE CHILDREN OF CLIENTS IN THE FOOD PANTRY. THESE BASKETS ARE SO WELL RECEIVED FROM THE PARENTS AND IT HELPS US BRING THE EASTER MESSAGE TO OVER 600 CHILDREN.

AS A MEMBER OF THE ALASKA VOAD (VOLUNTEER ORGANIZATION ACTIVE IN DISASTERS) WE ARE CONTINUING TO WORK ON THE RECOVERY EFFORTS IN WESTERN ALASKA FROM THE REMNANTS OF TYPHOON MERBOK. THE LONG TERM RECOVERY FOR THE REGION WILL COME THIS SPRING AS THE AKVOAD WILL BE HOSTING VOLUNTEER GROUPS FROM THE LOWER 48 WHO WILL BE COMING TO HELP REBUILD AND/OR REPAIR THE HOMES DAMAGED BY THE STORM. IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO BE A PART OF A TEAM HELPING TO REBUILD PLEASE LET ME KNOW.

SPRING IS IN THE AIR AND SOON WE WILL BE HEADING OUT TO OUR FAVORITE SUMMER ACTIVITIES. IF FISHING IS ONE YOUR FAVORITE THINGS TO DO YOU MIGHT NEED TO MAKE SPACE IN YOUR FREEZERS FOR THIS YEAR'S CATCH. WE WOULD LOVE TO HAVE ANY EXCESS FISH FROM LAST SEASON'S CATCH THAT YOU WOULD BE WILLING TO DONATE TO OUR FOOD PANTRY THAT OUR CLIENTS COULD ENJOY.
