Each town in New Hampshire may hold their celebration a little differently but the message remains the same: **welcome home.**

CANDIA OLD HOME DAY - A SUMMER TRADITION

➤ Date and Time

- Saturday, August 26, 2023 at Candia Moore Park from 11:00am - 2:00pm
- Moore Park is next to the Candia Town Hall located at 74 High Street (Rt. 27)
- **This is a rain or shine event**

➤ Availability of Space

- Registrations will be accepted from vendors on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- We will make every effort to accommodate the requests from vendors as to location of booth, proximity to food, music speakers, etc. However, we do have the final say over location of a vendor's booth.

➤ Logistics

- **Vendor set up is between 9am and 10:30am on event day.**
- Break down of booths is not allowed before 2pm.
- No vehicles are allowed in Moore Park during the event. Vendor parking is located behind our town highway department building or across the street near the library. Some handicap parking will be available if needed.
- Each organization, concession, and vendor is responsible for removing their own trash. Please look over your area before you leave to ensure it is clean and free of litter/debris.

➤ Space Dimensions/Special Requests

- Booths are arranged in 10' x 10' slots. Vendors: **please ensure your tent or awning and its guide wires will fit in a 10' x 10' space.** The park has limited shaded areas. If you need a shaded area please provide your own tent.
