Parade Policies and Safety Guidelines

1. Each group or individual should hold/displays a banner to identify themselves.
2. Passing out goodies/literature is permitted. Giveaways are the responsibility of the parade participant(s). Giveaways must be distributed to spectators hand to hand by parade participants walking along the parade route.
3. Alcohol and Smoking is PROHIBITED.
4. Float may be a car, truck, or float & must be in good taste.
5. Units in parade cannot exceed 5 mph.
6. Members may dress according to theme and carry theme related props.
7. All floats must have a fire extinguisher secured near primary access point.
8. All riders and units ride at their own risk.
9. Children below the age of eighteen (18) that are riding in the back of pickup trucks must be seated at all times behind rails or sides of the truck.
10. Trucks must have closed tailgates or enclosed backs. No parade participant may ride with feet hanging over the side of the float/vehicle.
11. No persons may ride on top or on the sides of any fire trucks and/or farm equipment that is in the parade.
12. Each pulled float must have a spotter in the pulling vehicle, other than the driver, viewing the back and communicating with the driver if/when a problem arises
13. If your entry includes animals, you are expected to have a waste detail walking immediately behind your entry with the appropriate shovels and buckets. Animals must be listed on the entry application.
14. You are expected to maintain control of your animal(s) at all times; riders not exhibiting control will be removed from the parade for their own and spectator safety.
15. Unless there is an emergency, participants are not allowed to get off of floats or vehicles or animals while it is in motion or anywhere on the parade route.
16. In order to limit clean-up costs, each entry is required to be equipped with plastic trash bags for depositing trash and litter accumulated by the entry's participants before, during and after the parade.
