THE BEST OF Y-TOWN WEEKEND

Any visit to Youngstown should include stops at the places that really make Youngstown shine: The Butler Institute of American Art, Mill Creek MetroParks (including Fellows Riverside Gardens and Lanterman's Mill), OH WOW! Children's Center if you're with the kids or Hollywood Gaming at Mahoning Valley Race Course if it's a grown-up getaway. Always check the schedules at CovelliCentre.com or StambaughAuditorium.com, and plan your visit around a great concert or special event!







HISTORY & HERITAGE

Our history is tied to the steel industry. Learn about the steelworkers and the wealth the industry brought to our area by visiting The Steel Museum and the Arms Family Museum. Enjoy lunch downtown at **Overture** and peek inside adjacent DeYor Performing Arts Center. a theater built by Youngstown natives, The Warner Brothers. I earn more about local

history at the Tyler History Center just

across the street. Find the Mill Creek Furnace next to Pioneer Pavilion in Mill Creek Park. This blast furnace, the first within the city limits, marked the beginning of the iron and steel industry in the Mahoning Valley. There are over 200 Ohio historical markers in our area. Visit remarkableohio.org and search Mahoning County to begin your hunt.



INSTAGRAM GOLD

Find Instagram gold spots to document your YO Tour on social media! A few local favorites include the overlooks at Fellows Riverside Gardens and Lanterman's Mill (get a selfie under "umbrella rock" on the trail near the Mill). Take mouthwatering photos of ice cream at one of several Handel's Homemade Ice Cream & Yogurt. Feature your wine selection on a scenic patio at one of our seven local wineries. Photobomb the steelworkers sculpture at Youngstown Historical Center of Industry & Labor (The Steel Museum), Pete the Penguin on the YSU Campus or the Indian sculpture outside The Butler Institute of American Art (just don't get too close!). Hike through 45 miles of trails in Mill Creek MetroParks, then rent a kayak or pedal boat. Hit Lake Milton State Park to explore a mountain bike trail, paddleboard, rent a pontoon or just relax on the beach. Bike the Mill Creek Bikeway or plan a round of golf we've got fantastic courses! Maybe disc golf is more your speed? We have courses in Boardman, Austintown and Wick Parks.

Plan your visit during a Youngstown Flea weekend, held monthly (Apr-Oct) next to the Covelli Centre in downtown Youngstown. It's a "Market for Makers" with wonderful local artisans displaying their wares, plus vintage and antique merchandise. Food trucks and curated music make for a fun atmosphere. After treasure hunting at The Flea, head to White House Fruit Farm, one of Ohio's best farm markets with delicious local produce and Ohio-made products. 
