Remote tune instructions

You will need

- 1. Functioning laptop with Microsoft Windows Operating System. (Google and Apple operating systems are NOT compatible.)
- 2. Internet access via Wi-Fi or a mobile hotspot. (If using a cell phone as a hot spot we recommend a secondary phone to be used to communicate with each other during this process.)
 - We understand that the internet can be "spotty" from time to time but please take into consideration that internet speed greatly affects the time it takes to tune on your vehicle.
- 3. Download the latest NSP (Nexus Software Programmer) software from Haltech, to include Data Log Viewer:
 - https://www.haltech.com/downloads
- 4. Download Anydesk software (Free version):
 - https://anydesk.com/en/downloads/windows
- 5. Vehicle is in working order and has had its initial start-up.
- 6. New Spark Plugs or less than 2,000 miles on them. (Street applications only)
 - If spark plugs are not changed and are within the mileage criteria verify spark plug gap is within range for your vehicle and no fouling is evident.
- 7. Minimum ½ tank of fresh, clean fuel that you will be running normally in the vehicle.
- 8. 10-15 minutes before your appointment, set up your laptop with the yellow communication cable supplied with your ECU and establish communication with your Haltech ECU.
- 9. Open your "Anydesk" program and you will get a remote access login with a specific address number. Using a cell phone, text this address to: (928) 706-2654. This number is NOT a support or office phone line. It is only to be used for communication during remote tunes. If you need assistance, call (928) 854-1320.
- 10. If you are unable to keep your scheduled appointment please inform us as soon as possible. We are car guys ourselves and know that builds don't always go according to plan.
 - If you miss your scheduled appointment and fail to let us know you will need to pay for your session in advance upon re-scheduling.
