



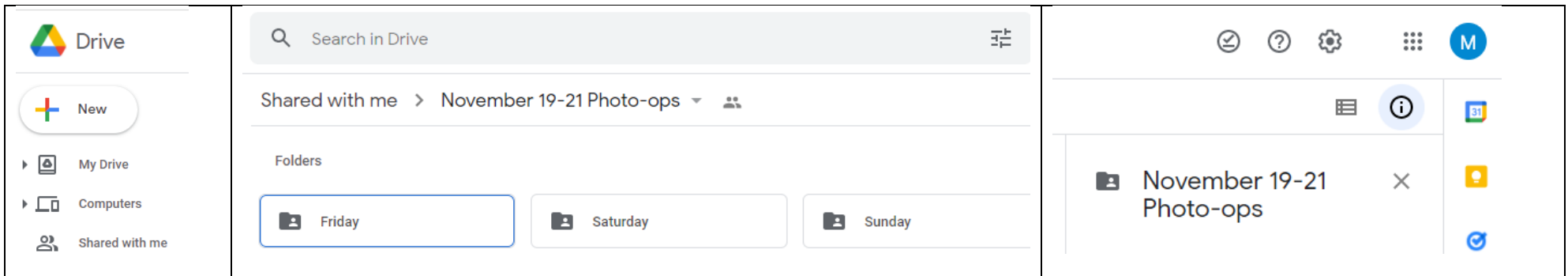

Photo Gallery Access

All Photo Ops are now available for digital download to your PC, smart phone or tablet.

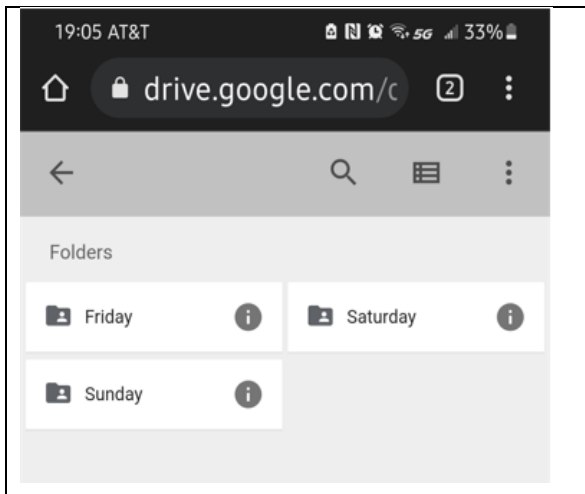
- 1) Just follow the link on the “Photo Op Gallery” section of our website or scan the QR code on a poster located near the Photo Op booth
 - This link will take you to our Google Drive directory
 - You do not need to have a Google Drive account to view and download your digital images
- 2) If you are already logged into a Google Drive account you will see a screen similar to Example A. Through a web browser you will see a screen similar to Example B. If you access Google Drive from your smartphone you will see a screen similar to Example C.
 - For best results, the preferred method for access is through a PC or tablet
 - Different devices and browsers may display Google Drive in slightly different ways



Example A, When accessed through your Google Drive account on a PC or tablet

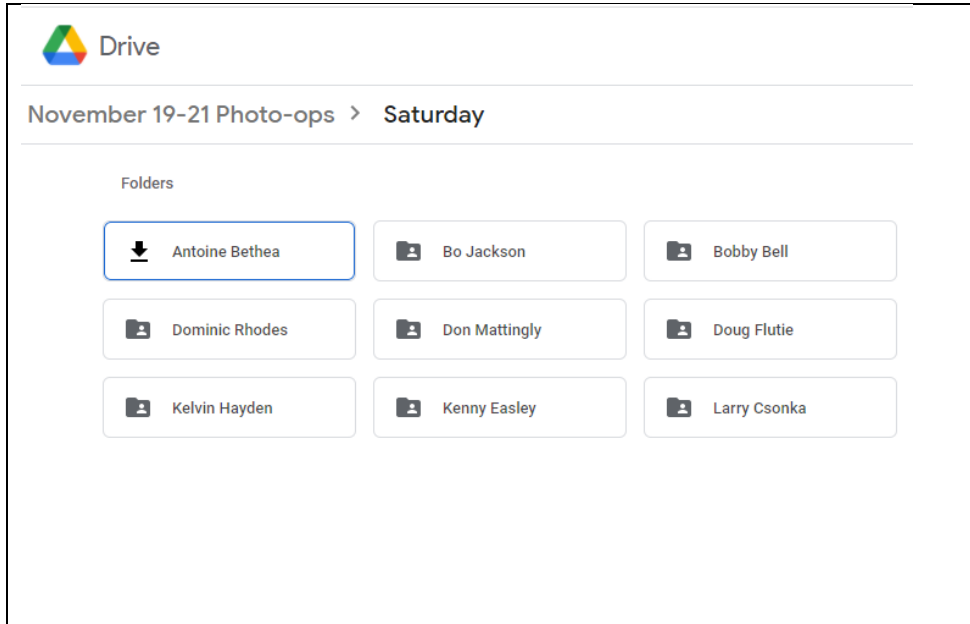


Example B, When accessed through a web browser such as Google Chrome on a PC or tablet

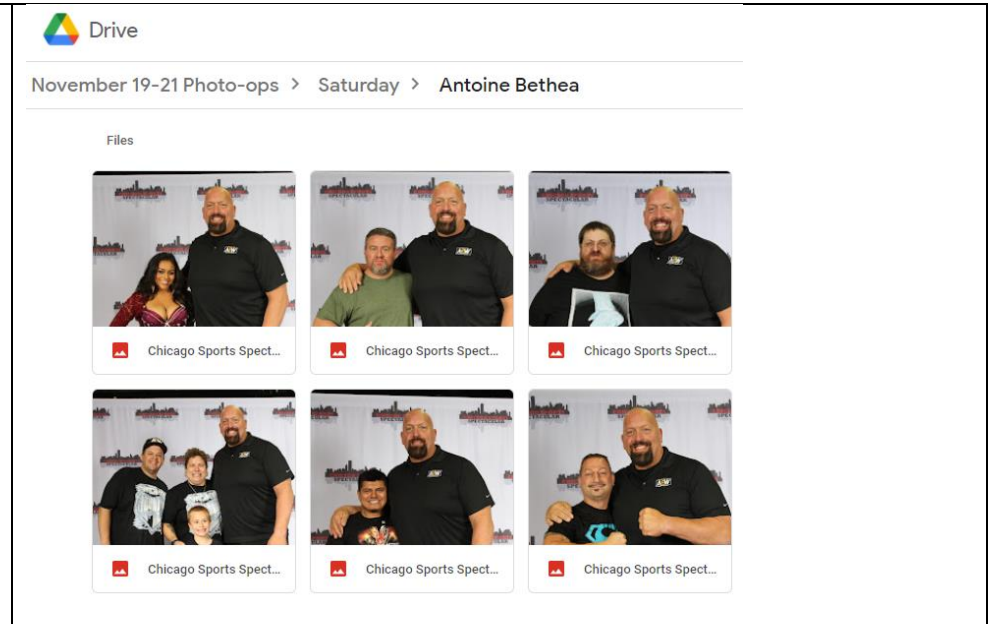


Example C, When accessed through a smart phone

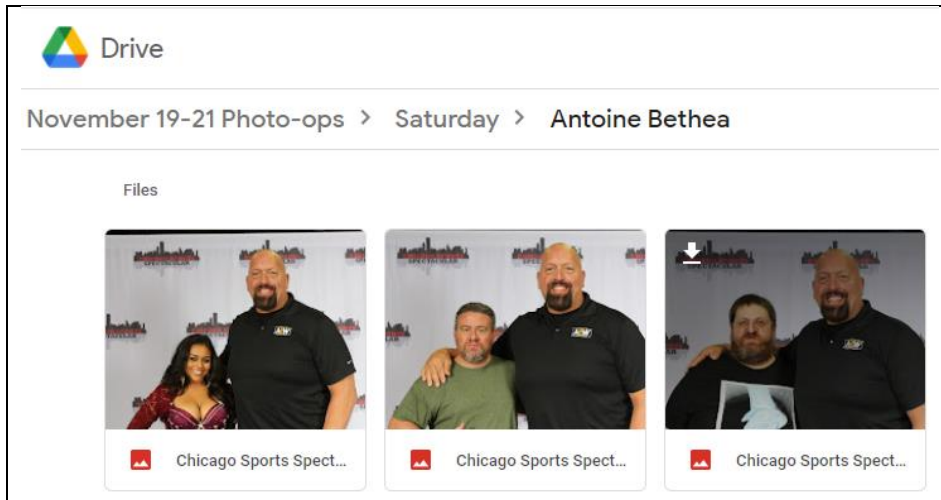
- 3) Click or tap the day (“Friday”, “Saturday” or “Sunday”) of your Photo Op to open the folder. Do not select the Download symbol (↓). A list of Photo Op guests will appear.
- 4) Click or tap the name of the guest that you took a Photo Op with. Do not select the Download symbol (↓). All pics for this guest will appear



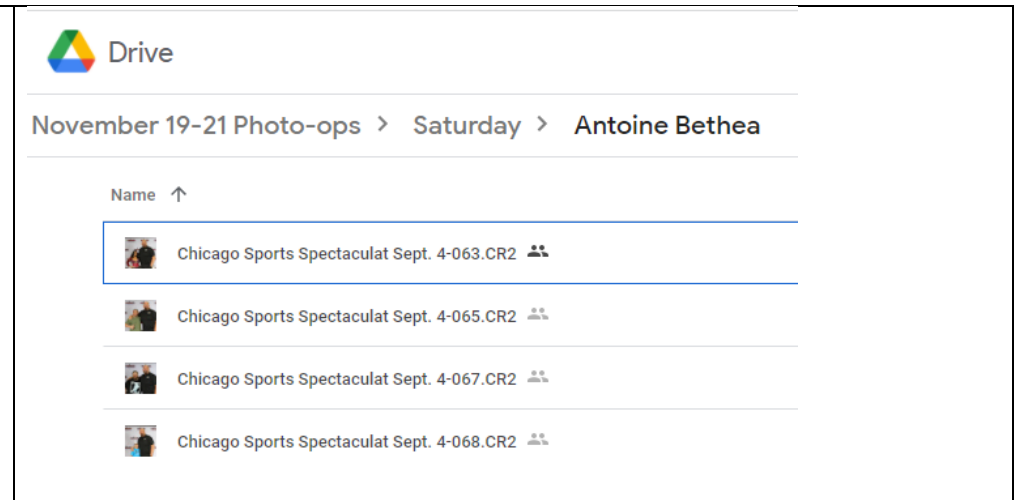
List of Photo Op Guests

5) Scroll until you locate your Photo Op digital image. Click or tap your pic and select the Download  symbol to download the image to your device where you can save it and print it to an attached printer.

Grid View vs List View

- If you want to switch to a grid view where you can see the large thumbnails of the images, click the grid icon,  usually on the upper right corner of the screen
- If you want to switch to a list view where you can see the file names of the images, click the list icon,  usually on the upper right corner of the screen
