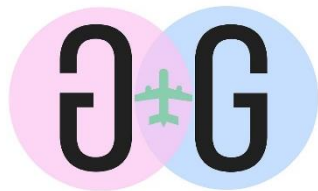

Day 1: Friday, March 20, 2026 Overnight Flight You are on your way to Egypt, ready to make the most of your journey in this fascinating country.

Day 2: Saturday, March 21, 2026 Cairo - Tour Begins Arrive in Egypt's capital city today and check into your hotel for the night. Tomorrow, Alexandria awaits! Enjoy time to get to know the place where your journey begins.

Day 3: Sunday, March 22, 2026 Cairo - Wadi El Natrun - Alexandria Embark on a northbound journey to Egypt's Mediterranean shores. A full morning bus transfer takes you to the early Christian monasteries of Wadi El Natrun. This valley is part of the greater Nile River delta, located slightly below sea level where mixing saltwater and freshwater marshes form unique conditions. During your time at Wadi El Natrun, visit an ancient monastery that's part of the complex of Orthodox Christian monasteries established by the Desert Fathers. After lunch at a local restaurant, continue on your bus transfer to Alexandria, where you'll arrive in the late afternoon for a two-night stay. (B, L)

Day 4: Monday, March 23, 2026 Alexandria Explore the "Pearl of the Mediterranean" on a guided tour of Alexandria today. Discover Alexandria's Hellenic roots, set in unique harmony with the ultramodern facade of the Bibliotheca Alexandrina. Explore this impressive institution, built as a reincarnation of the ancient Library of Alexandria founded some 2300 years ago. Continue on a panoramic tour and take in the city's sights, from Greco-Roman landmarks to old-world cafés and sandy beaches. Next, visit the city's Royal Jewelry Museum and peruse the collections belonging to Egypt's last dynasty that ruled the country from 1805 until 1952. Return to your hotel in the late afternoon and relax over an included dinner. (B, D)

Day 5: Tuesday, March 24, 2026 Alexandria - Cairo Say *Ma'a El Salama* to Alexandria as you board your train for the 3-hour journey back to Cairo. (B)

Day 6: Wednesday, March 25, 2026 Cairo - Pyramids of Giza This morning, get a glimpse into ancient Egypt's Pharaohs, power struggles, and dynasties during a visit to the Museum of Egyptian Antiquities.* Be prepared for a dose of Cairo's legendary traffic as you head to Giza. Fulfill a lifelong dream as you encounter the Pyramids of Giza, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, and marvel at the enigmatic Great Sphinx. Return to your hotel in the late afternoon and gather for a welcome dinner this evening. (B, D)

Day 7: Thursday, March 26, 2026 Cairo - Fly to Luxor - Board Cruise Ship Depart your hotel before dawn** for your flight to Luxor. Pause for a visit to the expansive Karnak Temple. Wander through this 4,000-year-old complex of pylons and obelisks, often of near-mythic proportions. Then, board your cruise ship for your 7-night voyage on the Nile River. After lunch on board, enjoy an afternoon at leisure to get familiarized with the ship. This evening,

take in the views from the sundeck before joining your fellow travelers for your first dinner aboard. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Friday, March 27, 2026 Luxor - Valley of the Kings - Afternoon Sailing Venture thousands of years into the past. As the sun rises, cross the Nile for a day in ancient Thebes. Explore the Valley of the Kings,** including the world-renowned tombs of Tutankhamun and Ramses VI. Visit the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut as well as the Colossi of Memnon. Return to the ship for a late lunch and settle in for views of the fertile banks of the Nile as you sail upstream towards Kom Ombo, where you'll arrive tomorrow afternoon. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Saturday, March 28, 2026 Morning Sailing - Kom Ombo - Afternoon Sailing Linger over a relaxed breakfast and a lazy morning on board. Take in glimpses of the small farms that dot the Nile's banks, appreciating the simple, modest livings of local farmers. In a place where daily life has changed little over the centuries, stay on the lookout for water buffaloes and other farm animals dotting the landscape. Later this morning, engage in an informative talk covering Egypt from past to present. After lunch, dock in Kom Ombo and explore its unique double temple. Return to the ship bound for Aswan, the Nubian City. This afternoon, enjoy a culinary demonstration and learn about the staples of Egyptian cuisine from your chef. Later on after dinner, dress up and join the fun during a traditional *galabeya* party. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Sunday, March 29, 2026 Aswan Consider a full-day optional tour to Abu Simbel**** to visit the extraordinary temples of Ramses II, saved from the rising waters of Lake Nasser during the construction of the High Dam. If you decide to sleep in, enjoy a day at leisure to explore Aswan. Perhaps you'll visit the fascinating artifacts at the Nubian Archeological Museum or stroll along the Corniche, Aswan's waterfront promenade. (B, L, D)

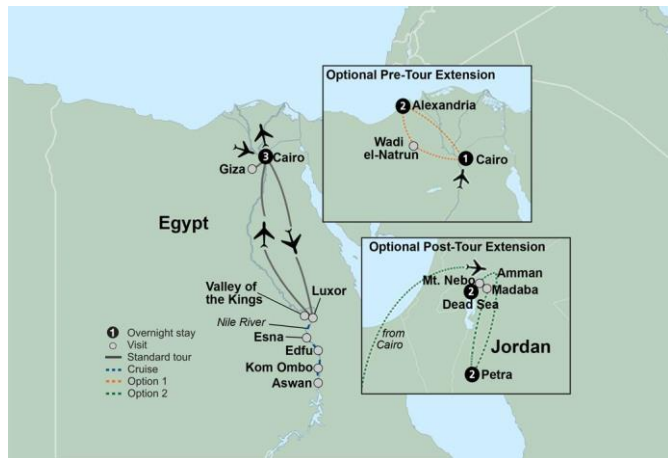
Day 11: Monday, March 30, 2026 Aswan This morning, hop on a motorboat for a ride to the sanctuary island dedicated to the goddess Isis. Philae Temple is among the architectural wonders rescued from the rising waters of the Nile during the building of the High Dam. Then, gain a different perspective on the epic construction of the dam during an up-close visit of the area, before returning to your ship for lunch. The afternoon is yours to explore more of Aswan. Perhaps you'll wander the local stores or search for spices in the local market, before regrouping for dinner aboard. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Tuesday, March 31, 2026 Aswan - Afternoon Sailing This morning, board a *felucca* (wooden sailboat) for a scenic sailing. As your time in Aswan draws to a close, take in the views of the tall sand dunes on the western shore of the Nile. Your ship sets sail once again after lunch for a relaxing afternoon heading downstream towards Edfu. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Wednesday, April 1, 2026 Edfu - Luxor Beat the heat with an early morning visit to the well-preserved Temple of Horus at Edfu. Peruse the endless carvings of scenes depicting the power and grandeur of the pharaohs. Return to the ship for your last stretch of sailing, docking in Luxor mid-afternoon. Upon arrival, visit the city's homonymous temple and walk among the mysterious human-headed sphinxes lining the ancient processional road to Karnak. After dinner on board, **it's your choice!** Linger aboard the ship **-OR-** join your guide for some time at the local *souk* (market), ending at a traditional café for a taste of mint tea. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Thursday, April 2, 2026 Luxor - Fly to Cairo Early this morning,***** return to Cairo. Head towards the old town to enjoy some free time to shop in the world-famous bazaar of Khan el-Khalili. Peruse colorful trinkets, hand-painted crafts, polished pendants, and more. Check into your hotel in the late afternoon, where this evening, you'll join your fellow travelers for a farewell dinner. (B, D)

Day 15: Friday, April 3, 2026 Cairo - Tour Ends Your adventure in Egypt ends today. Return home with a new understanding of this mystical land. (B)

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

Your itinerary includes many activities that require walking on uneven terrain and sand. Visiting tombs, temples and pyramids requires climbing and descending steep staircases and/or ramps with limited or no help from handrails. Some of these visits may not be suitable for people suffering from claustrophobia.

Visiting the Great Pyramid of Pharaoh Cheops in Giza requires agility as you will have to climb up steep, narrow steps (approximately 1-1 ½ feet tall) on the side of the Pyramid without the help of handrails. From there, you may access the inner chamber and will need to crouch and at times to crawl up the 300-foot (100-meter) narrow shaft with minimal help of handrails. This activity is usually not suitable for people suffering from claustrophobia.

***Visiting the Valley of the Kings requires walking on sand and mostly un paved paths. In addition, visiting the tombs requires navigating through multiple steep staircases and/or ramps with limited help from handrails. The tombs are located underground. This activity may not be suitable for people suffering from claustrophobia.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Temperatures can easily exceed 105° F (40.5° C), particularly in Luxor and Aswan. Be sure to bring adequate sun protection. We recommend having a hat or head cover, dressing in layers, and using natural, breathable fibers.

Your tour includes many early-morning departures. While in Cairo and Luxor, you may depart sometime between 3:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. to transfer to the airport for your internal flights. To ensure you profit from the cooler hours of the day and reach the sites ahead of larger crowds, you should expect to depart your hotel or ship between 5:30 a.m. and 7:30 a.m. for the visits of the Giza Pyramids, the Valley of the Kings, Edfu, and the optional tour to Abu Simbel.

****The exact flight schedule will be confirmed closer to departure. Due to limited flights, our departure from Luxor to Cairo will be at 6:30 a.m. or earlier, requiring a 4:00 a.m. departure from the ship. Occasionally, your visit to the Khan el-Khalili bazaar may take place during your first stay in Cairo.

The days and order of sightseeing may change to best utilize your time on tour.

Some of the most unique sightseeing can mean accessing locations that restrict motor coaches, especially in historic areas and archeological sites. For your comfort, we recommend bringing well broken-in walking shoes and always wearing socks to protect your skin from the friction of sand.

There is an additional cost to enter inside the Great Pyramid of Giza and special tombs in the Valley of the Kings. We cover the entrance fee to many sites and to some special tombs (King Tutankhamun and King Ramses VI tombs in the Valley of the Kings), but other special tombs/sites will be at your expense. Rates are subject to change at any time based on governing authority. Your Tour Manager will facilitate the onsite purchase of these tickets by collecting the fees at the beginning of the tour day.

Access to the interior of the Great Pyramid requires a separate ticket, for an additional cost of approximately \$40 US Dollars. The ticket can only be purchased on site and your Tour Manager will assist you with this request.

*The opening of the Grand Egyptian Museum is experiencing repeated delays. Once opening is confirmed, we will be pursuing ticketing and replacing the visit to the Museum of Egyptian Antiquities with a visit to the new museum.

****The optional tour to Abu Simbel includes round-trip transportation by air-conditioned motor coach, entrance fees, and lunch at a local venue (which replaces the lunch on board the ship). Please expect to depart the ship as early as 7:00 a.m., returning around 6:30 p.m.

Museum visits and shopping may be affected by observance of religious or local holidays. If traveling during the month of Ramadan, please note that the order of some features may vary and that some meal experiences may be replaced with meals in the hotel instead of local restaurants/venues. Ramadan and Eid observances are expected to fall between the evening of February 17, 2026 and the evening of March 22, 2026.

Due to cabin configuration, triple and child accommodations are not available.

The Egyptian government charges a camera and/or video fee of approximately \$18 US Dollars, per camera, for taking photos or video inside any enclosed sites such as tombs. Your Tour Manager can assist you with obtaining the necessary permission on site.

Each traveler is responsible for proper medical documentation and inoculations that may be required and/or recommended to participate on this tour. Please contact your local travel clinic or personal physician for specific details on the destinations you are traveling to and from.

Visit to the Royal Mummies Museum with Lunch

\$100 USD

Enrich your post-night stay in Cairo with a visit to the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization. This contemporary 5,300,000 square foot space sits in the historic neighborhood of Fustat. The museum first opened in 2017 and is home to a collection of 50,000 artifacts, tracing the Egyptian civilization from prehistoric times to today. On April 3, 2021 the world watched in awe as the Egyptian Ministry of Antiquities relocated here the Royal Mummies during the stunning Pharaohs' Golden Parade. The 22 mummies (18 kings and 4 queens) of Egypt's most important kings and queens were displayed on the streets of Cairo as they were transported from the Museum of Antiquities in Tahrir Square to their new home in the Museum of Egyptian Civilization. This large collection of royal mummies includes the likes of King Ramses II, the most famous pharaoh of the New Kingdom, and Queen Hatshepsut, who came to rule at a time when women did not become pharaohs. With the expert guidance of a local Egyptologist, enjoy a visit of this impressive museum – a perfect conclusion to your exploration of Egypt. The optional tour includes lunch in a local restaurant, is operated by a local representative, and requires guests to have a post-night hotel stay in Cairo. A post-night stay is required to participate in this optional tour. *Duration: Approximately 5 hours.* Transportation is included.

Ancient Sakkara with Lunch

Dive into Egyptian culture before your tour even begins. Enrich your pre-night stay in Cairo with a visit to Sakkara, the sweeping necropolis and pyramid field of Memphis, Egypt's first Capital. This is where pyramid building first began, 47 centuries ago when chief architect Imhotep built the grand step pyramid in honor of King Djoser. With the expert guidance of a local Egyptologist, enjoy a visit of this expansive burial complex, counting 11 pyramids and the impressive Serapeum, the burial site of the sacred Apis bulls. A perfect conclusion to your exploration of Egypt, your intensive exploration of Sakkara concludes with lunch in a local restaurant, before returning to your hotel mid-afternoon. The optional tour is operated by a local representative and requires guests to have a pre-night hotel stay in Cairo. A pre-night stay is required to participate in this optional tour. *Duration: Approximately 7 hours.* Transportation is included.

Abu Simbel Full Day Tour with Lunch

On this full-day tour, journey across the Western Desert, part of the legendary Sahara. A four-hour drive through this stark landscape takes you to the shores of Lake Nasser for a visit of the great sun temples of Abu Simbel. Built over 32 centuries ago by Pharaoh Ramses II, the temples were dismantled and moved in 1968 to save them from the flooding of the Aswan Dam.

During the visit, your Tour Manager – who is also an expert Egyptologist, will unveil the secrets of Ramses II's temple, its colossal statues, and the nearby shrine, dedicated to Queen Nefertari. After a local lunch, reminisce about the day as you relax on board your motor coach during your return journey to Aswan, where you arrive in time for dinner aboard the ship. *Duration: Approximately 12 hours.* Transportation is included.

Day 12: Cairo - Amman, Jordan - Petra

An early morning transfer brings you to the airport in Cairo for your flight to the Queen Alia Airport,* located in the outskirts of Amman, the capital of Jordan. Upon arrival, embark on an afternoon-long bus ride through the desertic countryside towards the ancient city of Petra. Arrive in Wadi Musa, Petra's modern-day settlement, for a 2-night stay. This evening, experience the flavors of the region during dinner at a local restaurant. *Today dinner will be included.*

Day 13: Petra

Early this morning, travel the short distance from your hotel to the archeological site of Petra (UNESCO). Enjoy a full day walking tour of this remarkable stone-carved city, one of the new Wonders of the World. This remarkable treasure of the ancient world remained "hidden" behind rugged mountains prior to its discovery in 1812, after being lost for over 500 years. Explore these breathtaking ruins, carved from sandstone by the Nabataeans and learn about the importance of Petra to the ancient trade routes, the history of its prominence and decline, its rediscovery, and efforts at preservation. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 14: Petra - Madaba - Mount Nebo - Dead Sea

A full morning transfer takes you to Madaba, the "City of Mosaics." Visit the church of St. George to see the famous 6th-century Byzantine mosaic map of the region, one of the oldest in existence. Meet the local community during a home hosted lunch and savor traditional Jordanian hospitality as you connect with your hosts over a traditional meal. In the afternoon, pause at Mt. Nebo, where Moses saw the Promised Land, and is believed to be laid to rest. In the early evening, descend to the lowest point on earth, for a two-night stay at a hotel featuring direct access to the legendary Dead Sea. Arrive in the early evening and enjoy a sunset overlooking the Promised Land. *Today breakfast and lunch will be included.*

Day 15: Dead Sea

Important Tour Extension Information:

The overall activity level of this extension is a level 3. This means walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal for you. You can navigate hills and uneven ground, climb into various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.), and could possibly anticipate changes in elevation. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable as is climbing 3 flights of stairs. You can handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet.
