### **POSITION SUMMARY:**

The Level 2 Field Technician is an experienced field role responsible for performing core pipeline integrity services such as pigging, tracking, surveying, hydro testing, and rig up/down. This position builds upon Level 1 duties and expects independent task execution, equipment proficiency, and mentoring of junior technicians.

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES/DUTIES:**

- Independently rig up/down field equipment including hoses, flanges, and temporary piping
- Track pipeline pigs/tools using geophones and receivers
- Perform DGPS survey field work using GPS equipment
- Perform pigging and hydro testing procedures with minimal supervision
- Load/unload pigs, and operate lifting equipment
- Assist Operators with separator jobs and flare operations
- Maintain field equipment and ensure operational readiness
- Help train and mentor Level 1 Pipeline Technicians
- Operate forklifts or other lift equipment to load and unload equipment and assist in job rig up/down
- Accurately complete field paperwork and job documentation
- Communicate progress and safety concerns to management or project Operator
- Travel by driving or flying with field crews to projects throughout the U.S.
- Follow all job site safety protocols and exercise stop-work authority if needed
- Perform other reasonable job duties as assigned
- Safely drive a company truck, pull trailers, and fill out DOT paperwork while traveling nationwide

#### **EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE DESIRED:**

- High school diploma or equivalent preferred
- At least 1 year of pipeline integrity field experience

- Valid Class C driver's license
- Must be willing to obtain TWIC card
- Complete company-provided safety training
- Ability to take test for job required operator qualifications

- Capable of mentoring junior crew members
- Able to navigate safely and efficiently while driving to various locations on a map
- Able to safely operate a ¾ ton pickup and pull an equipment trailer
- Able to operate basic forklifts, overhead cranes, and willing to learn operation of other heavy equipment.
