



MID ATLANTIC YACHT RACING ASSOCIATION
REPRESENTATION IN THE MID ATLANTIC MIDGET CHAMPIONSHIP (“MAMC”)

The Mid Atlantic Midget Championship (“MAMC”) is a competitive Opti and c420 regatta open to qualifying sailors from eight yacht racing associations (“YRA”) in the Mid-Atlantic region. The regatta location rotates among the eight member YRAs and was last hosted by MAYRA in 2023 (Brigantine).

Each YRA is permitted to invite two boats from each class to participate. As a championship regatta, each YRA is asked to send sailors with skill appropriate for competition in a championship level event.

Age limits are as follows:

Opti – Competitors cannot turn 15 in the calendar year

c420 – Competitors cannot turn 16 in the calendar year

MAYRA will track the finishes of age-qualifying SJSS participants, tabulate results, evaluate skill levels and extend invitations shortly following the conclusion of the fifth SJSS regatta.

MAYRA’s representatives will be selected based on the results of the first five SJSS regattas of the season. Scores will be tabulated using the low-point scoring system with one throw-out. In the event there are no championship caliber, age-qualifying c420 teams in MAYRA’s c420 fleet, MAYRA may invite age-qualifying sailors from other fleets to represent MAYRA in the c420 competition.

If an invited competitor declines the invitation, MAYRA will determine if an alternate invitation will be extended. Representation should be finalized on or before August 1st of each year.

The host YRA is permitted to fill any open slots to ensure a full field for competition.
