We are so sorry to announce that we have been informed, that the Public Health Team at North Lincolnshire Council, are cancelling <u>all</u> major events for the next eight weeks

We had anticipated some restrictions, and as a result, we looked into all possible options, including 'emergency' private venues close to Brigg. We investigated alternative routes out of the town, just incase any change in rules meant we couldn't go into residential areas. We had extensive back up plans in place, but despite us holding a very successful event just a few weeks ago, with extensive Covid 19 measures in place (that was attended by event organisers from across the country and shared nationally as best practice) we have been advised that we need to cancel, due to the current "R" number (reproduction infection rate) within the

We are obviously extremely disappointed and know that you will all be too We know that this will raise lots of questions, and we will do our very best to answer them. Sadly, for the Royal British Legion, this is a key fundraising event, and the loss of this is of huge detriment to them. We would love it if you were able to continue supporting them, and we have worked out ways that we could continue to do this:

- 1) Opt for your race place to become virtual. We will post you out a bespoke event running beanie hat (perfect for the coming cold!), the event medal and a cake :- ) We will do this automatically, unless you follow one of the below options. This option also means that the Royal British Legion will not lose out completely. Our number of entries are still at 50%, so feel free to nudge your friends to join us! (we will still have a virtual event day with prizes and results.)
- 2) Defer your place to next year. You can do this by doing the following:
