# The Skegness 10k 2026 Athlete Information Pack



## HELLO!

We're so happy we can bring back this classic winter flat and fast 10k event to Skegness for our second year!

The fabulous Skegness Coasters have done an amazing amount of hard work previously hosting the event and did a sterling job! (so a BIG THANK YOU TO THESE GUYS!), but sadly they weren't able to continue into 2023 ... so it's great that we get to now bring this event to the area!

## The Event

Expect a super flat and fast PB potential course as we make our way through the traffic-free seaside location amongst the caravans, starting and finishing in the grounds of Butlins caravan park!

The route is flat, fast and we've made it as spectator friendly as possible (we all love a good cheer and it keeps your spectators happier!)

They'll be aid stations on route, music throughout the course and greeting you at the finish will be your well deserved medal and tasty cake based treat!

The event is chip timed and will hold an England Athletics Licence :)

An extra thank you to those clubs, groups and organisations getting involved and making the day special for our runners - you'll see volunteers at various points cheering you on, so if you're not too tired, then shout them a thank you :)

## Race numbers, t-shirts and help!

Numbers are collected on the Sunday morning from the Pig and Whistle (Map below) We have pins provided with each number. Registration will be up and running from 09:00 ready for the event start at 11:00 (the start line you can see from registration)

Now we do appreciate it may be a 'tad' cold (or bracing!) but please be careful not to block up the Pig & Whistle as other runners need to come and go :)

You can also pick up friends/team mates/family members numbers. Just come armed with their surname or race number and their postcode so we can verify :)

**KNOW YOUR NUMBERS** - numbers are allocated in surname order but it helps for a super smooth registration if you know your numbers, these can be found in the final few days before the event on the website here: <https://curlysathletes.co.uk/skegness-10k> (we will send a note out) Then simply tell us your number at registration.

If you have pre-ordered an event t-shirt, you can collect at registration. We will have a limited amount for sale on the day at £11.00, as always our t-shirt profits go to support free entries for our charity chums, go as direct donations or help to fund our ongoing mission to help people get active... like opening up athletic tracks for communities to use for free or free kids coaching (we've loads of things going on) visit [www.getactivelocally.co.uk](http://www.getactivelocally.co.uk) to have a look!

**DO NOT SWAP NUMBERS!** This is to protect our runners, and in case of an emergency, we know who were looking after. We have a great LATE MATE system that helps you do this up to 48 hours before :)

**Bags!** We have very limited space at race HQ so no bag drop were afraid, please leave with spectators or in your vehicle :) This also supports our security measures and on that note please don't leave bags unattended.

**HELP OUR SEAL CHUMS- BRING A TOWEL!** We have some of the Skegness Natureland Seal Sanctuary team running in the event and we are collecting towels next to registration (make sure they are clean!) these will then be dropped off to some very happy seals !

## Event day timings

09:00-10:45 Number & T-shirt collection

10:45 Car park and entrance to site for vehicles close

10:50 the very short walk - we will begin moving/encouraging/dragging people to the start line, which is just outside the Pig & Whistle. Please position yourself sensibly at the start line, we have pacing boards out to help and its chipped timed so it starts when you cross the line ... it also reduces the risk of you going off too fast (which is the wrong way to approach a run!)

10:55 Race urgent announcements - We don't host a full race briefing on the day, its cold and hard to hear, so we put lots of information into this pack and out on our social media. However, any urgent elements / changes we will announce at the start line via a PA at the start line, so listen up .... If we've nothing to say then we will be quiet (ish)!

11:00 Event starts with a horn and lots of cheering.

11:30-32 (estimated) First finisher

12:15 - Prize giving will be in the Pig and Whistle (where registration was) We aim to gather the winners as we go for prize giving. We have overall winners male / female 1,2,3 and age group prizes in five year groups ... so check out the results online before you scoot off to see if you've won a prize (it's like a sweaty raffle!)



## Finding Your Way, Toilets, Parking & Spectators!

**Toilets** - We're shipping in portaloos (we all love a portaloos!) and these will be signed posted from registration, we also have toilets inside the Pig & Whistle . . . it will always involve a bit of queuing as 900 people all usually want to go at exactly the same time, but we've calculated the amount and we will all be ready and 'tinkled' for the race start.

**Parking** We have more parking this year with two car parks at the event and then our overflow carpark. **Please note our overflow car park will have limits on exit times due to it being in the run course.** We will support cars out as soon as we can, but please be patient and expect not to be released from this car park until the runners have cleared the area. PLEASE NOTE ALL PARKING AND VEHICLE MOVEMENTS WILL STOP AT 10:45 . . . so if you have spectators arriving they will need to be in for 10:45 the same as you lovely athletes.

The address is 50 Roman Bank, Ingoldmells, Skegness PE25 1NJ The run event and parking takes place in the static caravan park across the road from the main Butlins site (keep an eye out for yellow car park signs and arrows)

Please check out our car parking map for details (scroll on!) our car parking team will be directing you on the day, but a pre-read helps reduce questions on the day and make for speedier parking :) **\*\*We also strongly recommend car sharing to help and we've attached additional local car parking as parking is at a premium on the site\*\***

**Spectators** - Were assuming they'll be at the start to send you off, they also see you again on part of the loop and then again at the finish. They are welcome to head into course but be aware runners are running (odd that) so they will need to stay off the route and be very observant.

**Get involved and help make the day amazing!** If you fancy helping out on the course or setting up your own cheer station please get in touch and let us know. **Presentations, photos & Results** - Race winners, category winners (five year groups as per the live results) and any spot prizes will be given (where possible) during the race as we go along. Checking the results before you leave is a really good idea as our trophies mirror the result categories. Also if you are second in your age group it's worth a double check for if any of the 1,2,3 positions are in your age . . . if they are then the trophy rolls down!

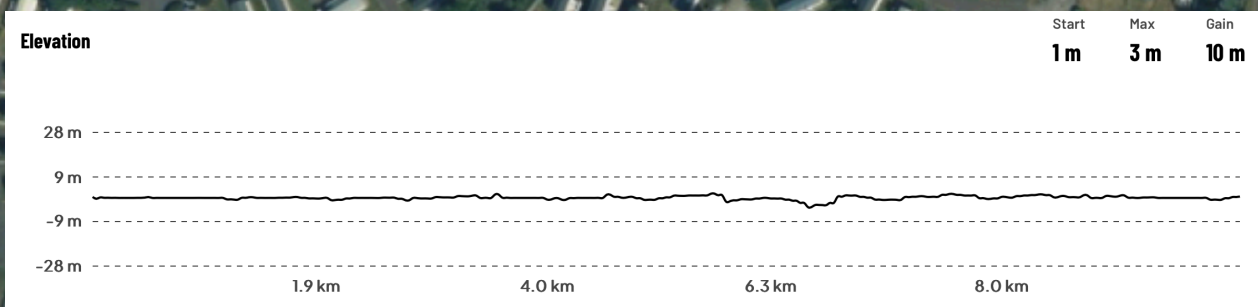

## The Start and Finish:

We thought it would be pretty handy to see what happens around the start and finish, it also helps keep your spectators informed so they don't get distracted by coffees and seagulls!

From the start you run past the registration area and then head in a big loop before returning to run back past the registration (just over 1k loop) before then heading out around the course. You then return back to the same area to head into the finish ... you get a good view of the finish for the final few hundred metres as you head in!

  - Any belongings deposited at a bag drop (if available) are left at the owner's risk.
  - I am fully aware of all associated risks involved with participating in this event
  - By entering this race, I give my permission to Curly's, its sponsors, assignees & licensees to use or authorise others to use photographs, motion pictures, recordings, data or any other record of my participation in this event for any legitimate purpose without remuneration.
  - I will listen to and respond to the advice given by race officials and marshals.
  - Headphones must not be worn (unless otherwise stated.)
  - **Event Cancellation:** If for reasons beyond the control of the Promoter, including an 'Act of God' due to unforeseen, naturally occurring events that were unavoidable, the event which applicants have entered is cancelled or postponed, the Promoters will issue a full Race Credit to the value of the original entry fee or transfer the applicant's entry to another race/events where requested.
