## Finding Santa and Parking

The event takes place at Sandall Park, 43 Sandalwood Close, Doncaster DN2 5DW

On the day of the dash the **main car park may be closed** as it will be used for event vehicles and set up :-) Parking is available in nearby residential streets (please don't block anyone's drive!) and there are lots of parking spaces along Barnby Dun Road, adjacent to the Stoneacre car garage (postcode DN2 4QP)

You'll have no problem finding our start line gantry... just follow the helpful Santa volunteers and all the other Santas (if you're taking part with family and friends, please check you leave with the same Santa you arrived with ;))

Where you can please arrange to share a car journey-one less car on the road is always good :)

## Suit or Antler Collection!

Most importantly you need to pick up your Santa suit (adults) and Antlers (kids) before the start **you will also be issued with a Santa Dash Number, you must wear this on the day to get a medal & mince pie :)** ... so here are your pick up options:

- Ready Steady Store (thanks guys!) on Wheatley Hall Road, Doncaster from the 27th of November until Thursday the 10th of December. (During normal office hours.)
- From Sandall Park- near the Santa start line until 10:30 on Saturday the 12th of December (please be aware park run will be happening on the morning, so please watch for runners... and of course cheer them on! )

**NB: You must have your payment receipt with you to collect your Santa number, Santa Suit or Antlers! Either printed on paper or by showing us your receipt on your phone.**

## Timings

- 10:30 Santa Dash Warm Up and Christmas music :)... Best dressed pups and junior Santa dashers! (our special guest will be wandering amongst the crowd picking out a few lucky winners !)
- 11:00 Santa's go dashing! ... maybe through the snow?

## Santas well-being

If you feel **unwell or injured** then it's your responsibility to withdraw from the event, please don't put yourself at risk. We will have plenty of manned Marshall points. Our team will be in radio contact so any problems go to your closest marshal and we will be able to get help to you asap.

**Santas reward!** At the end we have a **medal, a mince pie and a bottle of water** for you :)

**Rubbish,** At the end of the event we also have bottled water for you please either pop into a recycling bin or take home and recycle there. Please don't leave any rubbish anywhere but in bins, if the bin is full then take it home! Littering does not help hedgehogs or our other animal friends and **we wont invite back any intentional litterers. We will also add them to Santas naughty list :)**

**Wheelchairs, dogs, poo & push chairs-** dogs on a lead are welcome to join us on the course ... any poo must be cleared up please! The course is completely pushchair and wheelchair friendly :)

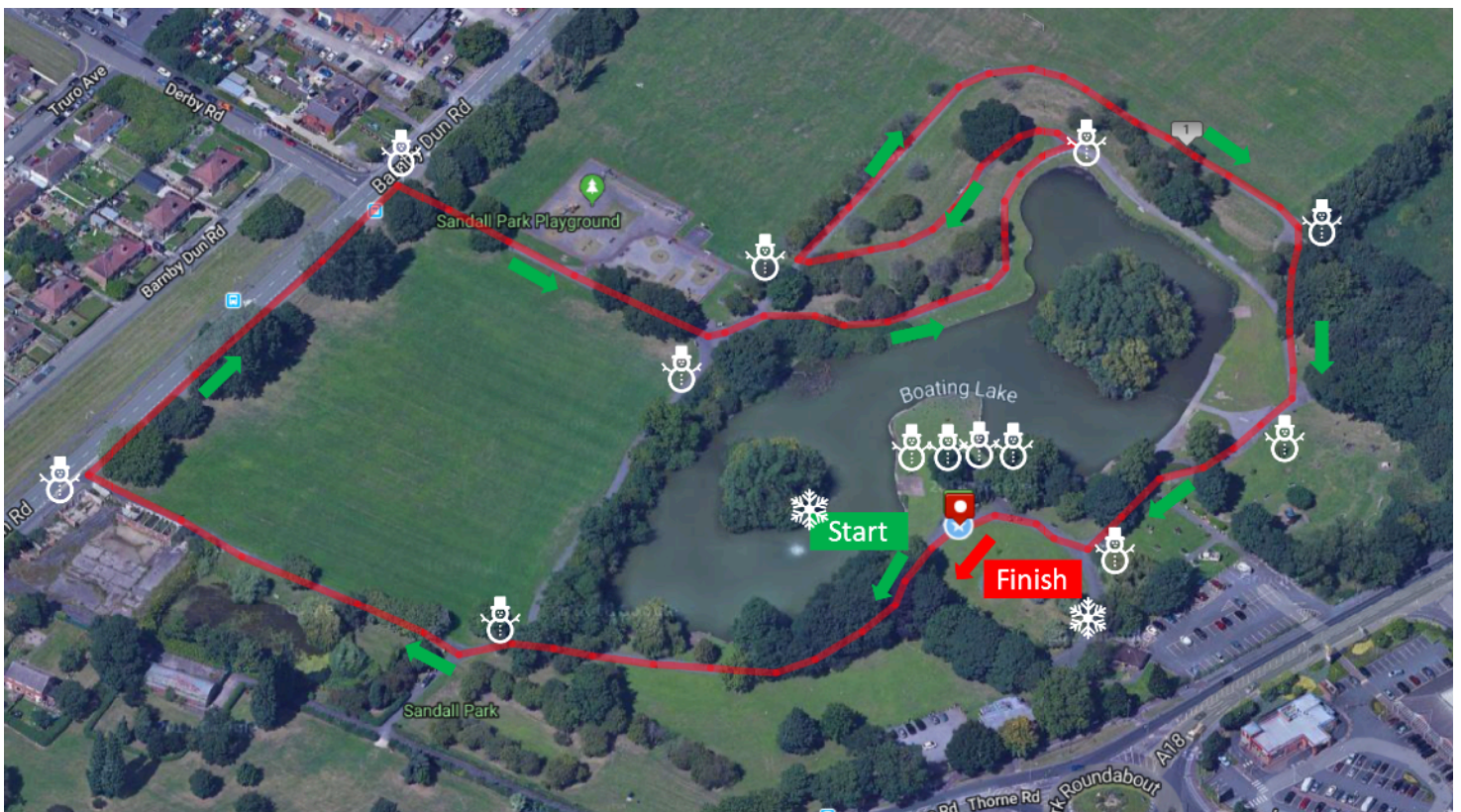
**Refreshments,** please pop into the Sandall Park Cafe to keep your energy levels topped up!

• Any belongings deposited at a bag drop are left at the owner's risk.

• I am fully aware of all associated risks involved with participating in this event

• By entering this race, I give my permission to Curly's, its sponsors, assignees & licensees to use or authorize others to use photographs, motion pictures, recordings, data or any other record of my participation in this event for any legitimate purpose without remuneration.

• I will listen to and respond to the advice given by event officials and marshals.

• **Event Cancellation:** If for reasons beyond the control of the Promoter, including an 'Act of God' due to unforeseen, naturally occurring events that were unavoidable, the event which applicants have entered is cancelled or postponed, the Promoters will issue a full Race Credit to the value of the original entry fee or transfer the applicant's entry to another race/events where requested. Alternatively, if an event is cancelled by the Promoter for non 'Act of God' reasons, the Promoters will offer a full refund.

• In the event of adverse weather or any other prevailing circumstances mean that the race is to be cancelled, details will be recorded on the web site and on the Facebook page.
