The Normanby 10k 27th June 2021, 08:30-10:30

We appreciate it's a strange time at the minute and for some the arrival of a 'running event' may cause mixed emotions.

However we wouldn't be returning to events if it wasn't safe to do so, and it's a situation we monitor daily.

The Normanby Hall 10k event is not as it was previously. We will not be having a mass of runners and spectators at the start/finish and its has been specially re-designed for the Covid-19 environment under UK Athletics guidance.

Covid-19 safe:

- The event is licensed under the new UK Athletics government guidelines and we have completely re-designed the event to enable it to go ahead safely. We have 750 runners spread over a 10km route.
- The start is staggered with runners set off staggered over 30 minutes, so you will see a steady flow of runners coming through your village. They are also been set off fastest first to help avoid overtaking. Expect to see the Bumblebee mascot at the back of the runners!

Access is via Thealby throughout

Approaching Normanby from Scunthorpe –

Turn left before Normanby Park Wall Side at Lodge Lane sign posted to Flixborough (signposted diversion / Flixborough).

Head through Flixborough and just after the church take a right turn and head to Burton upon Stather, at the end of Flixborough road junction turn left and then a quick right turn onto Barnston Way, at the end of Barnston Way turn left onto Burton High st (proceed with caution as runners will be on this road) follow this road all the way out of Burton.

Once you enter Thealby Village take the first right hand road (again proceed with caution as runners will be coming out of this junction turning left) This will lead you to the park car park or the golf club.

Leaving Normanby Park / Golf club — Only right turn available DO NOT TURN LEFT as the road is closed and you will be turn around. You can then head to Winterton to town or via Thealby / Burton / Flixborough (the reverse of the above route)

Accessing Scunthorpe from Burton Sunday 27th June 08:15-10:00 **THE NORMANBY 10K**



Access is via Flixborough (but can also be via Thealby to Winterton)

You will be unable to leave the village via Normanby and the road will be closed after the Playing fields area.

All roads in Burton village remain open but please take care as runners (and a bumblebee) will be passing through from 08:35-09:45

Turn down Flixborough road next to Burton Junior School (this can also be accessed via Barnston Way) Turn left before Barnston Way to continue on Flixborough Rd.

You will then leave Burton and continue on Flixborough Rd which becomes Burton Rd and take you into Flixborough village.

Turn left at the junction as this will take you down High St and Lodge Lane, leaving Flixborough.

As you arrive at the next junction turn right and this will take you to Scunthorpe via the B1430 Normanby Rd

This is also the route to access The Pony Club, Cricket Club & Farms at the South Lodge entrance of Normanby Hall). At the junction with Normanby road you would instead turn left. However this is a controlled access only so you will need to interact the the TM team in order to do this. The road is manned and coned further down to prevent access to Normanby so please only use to access these areas. The same applies if accessing from Scunthorpe direction for these sites.



Access for Burton from Scunthorpe direction Sunday 27th June 08:15-10:00

Approaching from Scunthorpe -

Turn left before Normanby Park Wall Side at Lodge Lane sign posted to Flixborough (signposted diversion / Flixborough).

Head through Flixborough and just after the church take a right turn and head to Burton upon Stather.

This will then lead you straight into the village. Please take care through the village as runners will be on the roads and paths.

Leaving Normanby Park / Golf club — Only right turn available DO NOT TURN LEFT as the road is closed and you will be turn around. You can then head to Winterton to town or via Thealby / Burton / Flixborough (the reverse of the above route)

Access for Burton from Winterton direction Sunday 27th June 08:15-09:30

Approaching from Winterton –

Down Coleby Road Hill from A1077 top Rd

Turn right around ½ a mile after the bottom of the hill towards West Halton Just before you leave West Halton take the last left and head towards Alkborough

Follow the road in Alkborough until you come to a Junction, at the Junction turn left and you will then head through Walcot village which then leads to Burton.

Down Thealby Lane from A1077 Top Rd

Turn right before Thealby towards Coleby.

Head through Coleby and then turn left through West Halton Just before you leave West Halton take the last left and head towards Alkborough

Follow the road in Alkborough until you come to a Junction, at the Junction turn left and you will then head through Walcot village which then leads to Burton.

This will then lead you straight into the village. Please take care through the village as runners will be on the roads and paths.
