Estimated 2015 Finances

The national office has a single source of income: membership dues. For 2014 there were 25 couples and 162 single paying memberships. There were also 11 emeriti and 18 chapter officers for whom dues are waived. The national office keeps \$55 per single membership and \$80 per couples membership. Assuming 100% renewals, 2015 income will be \$10,910.
