In early 2009 on one planned trip, four of us took to the field for a Quail Hunt. Dr. Chris Teigland and Joe Norcom paired-up, and Bill Curry and I took to an adjacent field.

Dr. Teigland found that his beautiful Alfred Lancaster side lever would not fire. Alfred was one of two gunmaking sons of the infamous Charles Lancaster and known for his high quality of manufacture. So, one can imagine that Dr. T. was very frustrated. Ever draw down on a bird and pull the trigger to have nothing happen?!

For those of you who

remember, the late Bill Curry was an official Shotgun Doctor. We all went to him for help diagnosing and fixing problems. His years of vintage gun experience made him an Encyclopedia of shotgun knowledge. Chris called over for help.

During the examination, it turns out that Joe Norcom was the better diagnostician. Joe spotted a tiny leaf fragment no bigger than a flat pea on the barrel flats. The gun seemed to open and close completely, but the triggers would not drop. The paper-thin leaf chip was wiped away and the 120-



year-old gun was good as new. Something as thin as a dry leaf fragment was keeping the gun from properly closing and hence locking up the strikers.



Chris wiped it off and everything was fine from then on...until the next time he had to clean his barrel flats for the same problem. Talk about precision tolerances...!

Description of the Alfred Lancaster pictured in this article: This handsome Anson & Deeley patent boxlock was made by the highly respected

London gunmaker, Alfred Lancaster circa 1885. A sidelever 12-gauge sporting 29-inch Damascus barrels also included a unique Sir Ralph Payne-Gallwey patent game counter inletted on the top rear of the comb. The straight grip stock and splinter forearm are made from French walnut. Lancaster was well known as the premier barrel maker of the period.
