Electrician

- 1. Installs, maintains and repairs electrical machinery equipment and fittings in factories, workshops power house, business and residential premises etc.
- 2. Studies drawings and other specifications to determine electrical circuit, installation details etc.
- 3. Positions and installs electrical motors, transformers, switchgears.
- 4. Switchboards and other electrical equipment, fittings and lighting fixtures.
- 5. Makes connections and solders terminals.
- 6. Tests electrical installations and equipment and locates faults using megger, test lamps etc.
- 7. Repairs or replaces defective wiring, burnt out fuses and defective parts and keeps fittings and fixtures in working order.
- 8. May do armature winding, draw wires and cables and do simple cable jointing.
- 9. May operate, attend and maintain electrical motors, pumps etc

ITI Fitter is a short term professional technical course, In which you are taught about different types of fittings. It is a mechanical branch in which you are given the knowledge to fit different types of machines, pipes, structures.

Fitter

- 1. Sizes metal parts to close tolerances and fits and assembles them using hand tools for production or repairs of machines, or other metal products.
- 2. Studies drawings to understand specification of different parts, fittings or assembles to be made and their functions.
- 3. Holds the work in Vice, Cuts and shapes required parts to dimensions and specifications by processes of sawing, chipping, filing, grinding, drilling holes, screw cutting, scrapping etc.
- 4. Measures object while working using foot rules, calipers, micrometer, gauges etc.
- 5. Clamps object securely in correct position in vice and files it to required dimensions according to punchmarks and guide lines frequently measuring it with callipers, micrometer, vernier, gauges etc, makes holes with drill, cuts threads with taps and dies ensuring that they are square or at Required angle to base
- 6. Dismantles or removes worn out, broken or defective parts using hand tools or power tools and replaces them by repaired or new ones

The course is of one year duration. It mainly consists of Domain area and Core area. The Domain area (Trade Theory & Practical) imparts professional skills and knowledge, while the core area (Employability Skill) imparts requisite core skills, knowledge, and life skills. After passing out the training program, the trainee is awarded National Trade Certificate (NTC) by NCVT which is recognized worldwide.

General Rules & Regulation

Admission Policy

- 1. All admission shall be on provisional basis and subject to confirmation of admission by the university / Council
- 2. The selection is made strictly on basis of merit and no separate entrance fee is charged, regarding selection, decision of Mission management is final. Any candidate found including in any sort of unfair means during the selection procedure is automatically disqualified.
- 3. All fees must be settled in full prior to the commencement of course.

Institution Rule & regulation



- 1. Once the students admitted the fees paid will not be refunded on any circumstances.
- 2. School/College Leaving, Board Certificate and Migration Certificate in original should be deposited in the institute at the time of admission and the same will be returned after the course is over except CLC / SLC.
 - 3. Every trainee withdrawing/dismissed (On Disciplinary ground) during training should pay the fee for the remaining training period.
 - 4. Fees should be paid by 10th of designated month failing which fine will be charged @ Rs.10/- per day of default. Failure to pay fees over two months will lead to dismissal from the institute / Hostel.
 - 5. Any trainee whose work is unsatisfactory and does not show any significant improvement may be removed from the institute.
 - 6. Regular attendance is mandatory. Students with less than 90% attendance will not be permitted to sit for the ensuing /final examination.
 - 7. All the practical work and drawing work should be completed in the institute premises only. If work is not completed within the stipulated time, the trainee will not be permitted to sit for the ensuing final examination.
 - 8. A trainee who does not obey all orders given by the management and instructors must suffer the consequences. Usually the trainee will be given hard labour duties, Fines, suspension and in extreme cases, even dismissal may be given as punishment.
 - 9. The institute timings must be strictly followed. The late comers will forfeit half a days attendance.
 - 10. No leave of any sort will ordinarily be granted except in the case of trainees sickness or in emergency. Sick reports must be substantiated with a medical certificate. The institute may insist on a countersignature by a civil surgeon.
 - 11. Attendance on the first and last day of term as well as days proceeding and succeeding holidays is important. Absenteeism on these days will be penalized by fines.
 - 12. No trainees will be permitted to appear any outside examination while attending this institute except with the prior permission of the principal.
 - 13. Trainees found stealing or damaging institutes property will be summarily punished by suspension or dismissal.
 - 14. Certificate will be awarded only after fulfilling all the required conditions of award and after the trainees has settled all dues with the institute.
 - 15. Consumption of Alcohol, Tobacco Products (Khaini, Tiranga, Panparag, Pan, Tulsi etc.) & using cell phone will be viewed seriously. Students found guilty on these offences will be dismissed from the institution without further clarification.

General Nursing

Diploma in General Nursing and General nursing is an undergraduate Nursing course. Nursing and General nursing focuses on the individuals, families, communities so they may attain, maintain, or recover optimal health and quality of life from conception to death. The time period of General Nursing and General nursing is three academic year, but it varies from institute to institute. The S.R.M. University is providing in three and half years including six months internship. The minimum time to complete the course is also differentiating from institute to institute. The course may also be available on a part-time basis in some certain institutes. The diploma course is an important and job orienting in nature.
