

The Law of Moses compared to the 10 Commandments

Evidence of Two Spoken

Luke 2:22: “And when the days of purification according to the **Law of Moses** were accomplished, they brought him to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord. “

Joshua 8:32: “And he wrote there upon the stones a copy of the **Law of Moses**, which he wrote in the presence of the children of Israel.”

Luke 24:44: “These are the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the **Law of Moses**, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning me.

Daniel 9:11 “Yea, all Israel have transgressed **thy law (Law of God)**, even by departing, that they might not obey thy voice; therefore the curse is poured upon us, and the oath that is written in the **Law of Moses** the servant of God, because we have sinned against Him.

Evidence of Two Spoken

Psalms 19:7: “The **Law of the Lord** is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple.”

Romans 7:22: “For I delight in the **Law of God** after the inward man...”

Romans 8:7: “Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the **Law of God**, neither indeed can be.”

Deuteronomy 4:13: “And he declared unto you his **covenant**, which he commanded you to perform, even **Ten Commandments**; and he wrote them upon two tables of stone.”

Deuteronomy 10:4: “And he wrote on the tables, according to the first writing (first works), the Ten Commandments, which the Lord spake unto you in the mount out of the mist of the fire in the day of the assembly...”

Written by Moses in a Book

2 Chronicles 35:12: “And they removed the burnt offerings, and they might give according to the divisions of families of the people, to offer unto the Lord, as it is **written in the book of Moses.**”

2 Kings 14:6: “But the children of the murderers he slew not: according unto that which is **written in the book of the Law of Moses**, wherein the Lord commanded, saying, the fathers shall not be put to death for the children, nor the children be put to death for the fathers; but every man shall be put to death for his own sin. “

Written by God on Stone

Exodus 31:18: “And he gave unto Moses, when he had made an end of communing with him upon mount Sinai, two tables of testimony, **tables of stone, written with the finger of God.**”

Exodus 32:16: “And the tables were the work of God, and the **writing was the writing of God, graven upon two tables.**”

Placed Outside the Ark

Deuteronomy 31:24-26: “And it came to pass, when Moses had made an end of writing the words of this law in a book, until they were finished, That Moses commanded the Levites, which bare the ark of the covenant of the Lord, saying, Take this book of the law, **and put it in the side of the ark** of the covenant of the Lord your God, that it may be there for a witness against thee.”

Placed inside the Ark

Exodus 40:19-20: “And he spread abroad the tent over the tabernacle, and put the covering of the tent above upon it; as the Lord commanded Moses. And he took and **put the testimony in the ark**, and set the staves on the ark, and put the mercy seat above upon the ark...”

Temporary (Ended at the Cross)

Colossians 2:14: “Blotting out the **handwriting of ordinances** that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to the cross.”

Ephesians 2:15: “Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the **law of commandments contained in ordinances**; for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace.”

Ordinances are man-made local laws; Statutes are State Laws.

Ezekiel 44:24: “And in controversy they shall stand in judgement; and they shall judge it according to my judgements: and they shall keep my laws and my statutes in all mine assemblies; and they shall hallow my Sabbaths.”

2 Kings 17:19: “Also Judah kept not the Commandments of the Lord their God, but walked in the Statutes of Israel which they made.”

Many verses also talk about God’s ordinances and statutes like in Psalm 119 – this is simply God’s voice and instruction and is figuratively speaking. Wherein other verses may refer to Israel’s or Levitical ordinances and Statutes that were added, which sometimes Paul just calls “law”, but refers to the 613 Laws of Moses in context. Some of these laws had sacrificial, ceremonial, dietary, priest and economic laws contained therein. These ended with the destruction of the temple in 70AD. Pharisees over many decades also added many manmade laws to this list, building them beyond 613 and some added only by oral tradition.

Christ rebukes the Pharisees many times by unjust judgements and hypocrisy because of these “traditions of men,” where they created their own self-righteousness, instead of standing on God’s righteousness.

Will Stand Forever

Luke 16:17: “And it is easier for heaven and earth to pass, than one tittle of the law to fail.”

Matthew 5:17-20: “Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfill. For verily I say unto you, **Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, til all be fulfilled.** Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least Commandments, and shall teach others to do so, he shall be called least in the Kingdom of Heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the Kingdom of Heaven. For I say unto you, that except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the Kingdom of Heaven.”

Deuteronomy 6:25: “**And it shall be our righteousness**, if we observe to do all these Commandments before the Lord our God, as he hath commanded us.”

Leviticus 24:8: “Every Sabbath he shall set in order before the Lord continually, being taken from the children of Israel, being taken from the children of Israel by an **everlasting Covenant.**”

Deuteronomy 4:40: “Thou shalt keep therefore his statutes, and his Commandments, which I command thee this day, that it may go well with thee, and with thy children after thee, and that thou mayest prolong thy days upon the earth, which the Lord thy giveth thee, **forever.**”

Deuteronomy 5:22: “These words the Lord Spake unto all your assembly in the mount out of the midst of the fire, of the cloud, and of the thick darkness, with a great voice: **and he added no more.** And he wrote them in two tables of stone, and delivered them unto me.”

Deuteronomy 7:9: Know therefore that the Lord thy God, he is God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations.

1 Chronicles 16:15-18: Be ye mindful always of his covenant; the word which he commanded to a thousand generations; Even of the covenant which he made with Abraham, and of his oath unto Isaac; And hath confirmed the same to Jacob for a law, and to Israel for an everlasting covenant.

Is the law sin? God forbid. <p style="text-align: center;">Contrary To Us, Against Us</p> <p>Colossians 2:14: “Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us</p> <p>Deuteronomy Chapter 28 – 29 – Blessings for obeying the Commandments, Curses for disobeying the Commandments.</p> <p>Galatians 5:4 “Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the law; ye are fallen from grace.”</p> <p>1 Timothy 1:9: “Knowing this, that the law is not made for a righteous man, but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and for sinners, for unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers”</p> <p>Deuteronomy 28:45 “Moreover all these curses shall come upon thee, and shall pursue thee, and overtake thee, till thou be destroyed; because thou hearkenedst not unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep his commandments and his statutes which he commanded thee”</p> <p>Deuteronomy 29:21 “And the LORD shall separate him unto evil out of all the tribes of Israel, according to all the curses of the covenant that are written in this book of the law”</p> <p>Read the rest of Deuteronomy 29 on why God did this!</p> <p>Romans 7:25: “I thank God through Yeshua Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin.”</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Not Grievous</p> <p>1 JOHN 5:3: For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his <u>commandments are not grievous.</u></p> <p>Galatians 5:18: “But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law.”</p> <p>Galatians 5:23: “Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.”</p> <p>1 Timothy 1:8 But we know that the law <i>is</i> good, if a man use it lawfully</p> <p>Revelation 14:12: Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Yeshua.</p> <p>Hosea 8:12: “I have written to him the great things of my law, <i>but</i> they were counted as a strange thing.”</p> <p>Psalms 1:2: “But his delight <i>is</i> in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditates day and night.”</p> <p>Psalms 40:8: “I delight to do thy will, O my God: yea, thy law <i>is</i> within my heart.”</p> <p>Psalms 119:34: “Give me understanding, and I shall keep thy law; yea, I shall observe it with <i>my</i> whole heart.”</p> <p>Proverbs 29:18 Where <i>there is</i> no vision, the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy <i>is</i> he.</p> <p>Romans 7:12: “Wherefore the law <i>is</i> holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good.</p> <p>Revelation 22:14: “Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.”</p>

For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill. Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill, thou art become a transgressor of the law. So speak ye, and so do, as they that <u>shall be judged by the law of liberty.</u>”</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Carnal (In the Flesh – Like Hagar)</p> <p>Hebrews 7:16: “Who is made, not after the law of a carnal commandment, but after the power of an endless life.”</p> <p>Ephesians 2:15: “Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, <i>even</i> the law of commandments contained in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, <i>so</i> making peace”</p> <p>Galatians 3:3: “Are ye so foolish? having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made perfect by the flesh?”</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Spiritual (By Promise - Like Sarah)</p> <p>Ephesians 2:12: “That at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world”</p> <p>Romans 7:14: “For we know that the <u>law is spiritual</u>: but I am carnal, sold under sin”</p> <p>Galatians 3:5 “He therefore that ministereth to you the Spirit, and worketh miracles among you, <i>doeth he it</i> by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?”</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Made Nothing Perfect</p> <p>Hebrews 7:19: “For the law <u>made nothing perfect</u>, but the bringing in of a better hope did; by the which we draw nigh unto God.”</p> <p>Hebrews 10:1 “ For the law having a shadow of good things to come, <i>and</i> not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto perfect.”</p> <p>Hebrews 10:28: “He that despised Moses’ law died without mercy under two or three witnesses”</p> <p>2 Corinthians 3:9: “For if the ministration of condemnation <i>be</i> glory, much more doth the ministration of righteousness exceed in glory.”</p> <p>Read 2 Corinthians 3 – comparisons between “Spirit” which gives life and “Flesh” which gives death. This comparison is also made between Horeb (Spirit) and Sinai (Flesh), which is Hagar and Sarah or the 10 Commandments spoken versus the 10 Commandments on Stone versus the Laws written in a book.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Perfect</p> <p>Psalms 19:7: <u>The law of the LORD is perfect</u>, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple.</p> <p>Read all of Psalm 119 – All about the Law of God</p> <p>Psalms 37:31: “The law of his God <i>is</i> in his heart; none of his steps shall slide.”</p> <p>Proverbs 4:2: “For I give you good doctrine, forsake ye not my law.”</p> <p>Hebrews 7:28: “For the law maketh men high priests which have infirmity; but the word of the oath, which was since the law, <i>maketh</i> the Son, who is consecrated for evermore.”</p> <p>James 1:25: “But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth <i>therein</i>, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.”</p> <p>James 2:22: “Seest thou how faith wrought with his works, and by works was faith made perfect.”</p>
