Should Christians Celebrate Halloween?

As servants of Yehovah we are supposed to be obedient to all the words that proceed out of his mouth & what is written in the bible. We are not supposed to have any relations with the works of darkness AS we become saints. The church has compromised its purity by adopting pagan festivals, which has led to spiritual corruption.

The Root Cause: Christian Adoption of Pagan Holidays

• The root problem is the church's incorporation of pagan festivals like Christmas and Easter. These holidays, originally heathen in nature, were "Christianized" but remain inherently linked to idolatry. Christmas falsely claims to celebrate the Messiah's birth on December 25th, whereas biblical evidence places Yeshua's birth in the spring. This has led the church away from true worship and increased sin.

Biblical Warnings Against Idolatry

• Referencing 1 John and Jeremiah 10, they specifically mention the Christmas tree as a symbolic "Ashtaroth pole" linked to Baal worship, which led to Israel's divine rejection. The church's embrace of such symbols is the spiritual equivalent of repeating Israel's mistakes, risking spiritual "cutting off" as warned by Paul. Idolatry is the foundational sin causing the church's downfall.

Boasting Against the Natural Branches

• The phrase "boasting against the natural branches" is the church arrogantly claiming spiritual superiority while committing the same sins as Israel. This self-righteousness ignores the warnings that those who practice idolatry will face judgment. The church's adoption of pagan customs places it in the same category as apostate Israel.

The Fruit of Idolatry: Acceptance of Halloween

• The church's tolerance of Christmas and Easter has paved the way for the acceptance of Halloween, which is explicitly pagan and satanic. Tolerating one form of idolatry inevitably leads to further spiritual compromise.

Spiritual Sacrifice and End Times Prophecies

• Looking at the Old Testament prophecies, we can see that the church's idolatry is the same thing as the "passing children through the fire to Moloch." This is interpreted spiritually because the church participates in pagan rituals, symbolizing a deep apostasy that fulfills end-times warnings. These prophetic images are being repeated today, reinforcing the urgency of repentance.

Rejection of False Traditions and Idols

• True followers of the Messiah reject pagan customs such as Christmas trees and Easter bunnies. They cite Deuteronomy 32 and other scriptures to emphasize the necessity of rising up against these sins within the church before tribulation arrives. This call to repentance is necessary for purification of the faith community.

The Role of Jacob and the Second Exodus

• The time is now for the spiritual awakening led by "Jacob," an idiom for the watchmen apostate church. This awakening will precede the second Exodus, representing a gathering of the true faithful who have rejected idolatry. Even among these faithful, some will rebel and be purged, referencing the biblical imagery of wheat and tares growing together.

Rejecting the Ways of the Heathen

• This is a direct call to Christians to "learn not the ways of the Heathen," echoing Jeremiah and John's teachings. The church's current path is one of delusion, falsely believing in rapture and deliverance while embracing pagan abominations. This results in a "strong delusion" that will lead many astray.

But the portion of Jacob isn't like them that does these things, because he doesn't deny the Messiah's name, he doesn't do idolatry. But they hate Jacob because he tells them these things. "Little children keep yourselves from idols" was a rebuke against Christmas and Easter: Christmas trees and Easter Bunnies. Jacob has to rise up out of the church and rebuke the church of their sins before tribulation comes. Because most people aren't going to listen, they go into tribulation. Those that are ignorant are held in ignorance and will go into the second exodus.

When you reflect on Halloween, does "light" come to mind at all, or darkness?


Loving traditions of men will not get you into God's kingdom. We are told in Job 14:4 "Who can bring a clean thing out of an unclean? not one.", yet the churches still try to Christianize these pagan holidays. If those within the church do not repent, they will end up in great tribulation or worse. Just as Israel transgressed against the Father in the beginning with the golden calf, then were put under sacrificial law for a time in hopes they would repent and turn back (they didn't and their punishment was x7), only to transgress again ultimately getting divorced/exiled from Yehovah through idolatry once again (2 Kings 17). Idolatry is spiritual adultery against the Father. How much sorer of a punishment will they receive after claiming to love God yet breaking his commandments? If they loved him they would obey the 10 commandments (Exodus 20 & Deuteronomy 5). We are told to be children of the light not the darkness.

Ephesians 5:8 For you were sometimes in darkness, but now are you light in the Lord: walk as children of light:

How can you partake in these pagan traditions while still claiming to love God?

Halloween is all sorts of evil, once again you cannot love Yehovah and do these traditions of men. This is what the church likes to do, developing their own form of self righteousness picking and choosing what they can and can't do. They do this by having a zeal for God, but not according to his righteousness/knowledge. Christians celebrating Halloween just shows you how apostate the church is. It's the most obviously pagan festival of the heathens and somehow they think they can Christianize it, it's just bizarre. There's even a good chunk of Christians that sort of forsake Halloween and say no it's not of God but then they're still hypocrites because they do Christmas and Easter. It's because the church did Christmas and Easter they learned the ways of the heathen and they've done so in the name of Baal, in the name of Jesus, thinking that they're doing it for God. "Tomorrow is a feast unto the Lord" claiming it's the Messiah's birthday when it's not, the Messiah was born in the spring. It's because they've even done that, that sin has increased. John tells you in 1st John to keep yourself from idols because the sin that leads to death is idolatry and Jeremiah 10 shows you what those idols are, the Christmas tree, the Ashtaroth pole, that Israel brought into their homes and decorated all in the name of Baal and Ashtaroth. That's why God divorced them. That's what it means to boast against the natural branches, they have made the same mistake as them in claiming they're delivered to do those abominations. What does Paul say to those who do that, because they've done the same mistake, he says how much sooner will you be cut off that do the same thing that Israel did to get cut off?

1 Thessalonians 5:22 Abstain from all appearance of evil.



Do you want to hear, "Depart from me, I never knew you."???

Matthew 7:21-23 Not every one that says to me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that does the willof my Father which is in heaven.

Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in your name? and in your name have cast out devils? and in your name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, you that work iniquity.
