GUIDELINES AND RULES

This challenge event is open to Rotary Clubs in our area. Your club's participants **do not have to be Rotary members**, however they will be "sponsored" by your club. Recruit family members, friends, business associates! For simplicity we ask that your Rotary Club send in the entry fee to the BV Rotary and you collect accordingly (if desired) from your participants.

Come to float AND/OR come up with a team theme & costumes or BOTH - wow the crowd that will cheer you to shore and have a chance to win in two categories! Or just join in the fun and leisurely float with the crowd.

AM Check-in & On-site Registration at Launch Site (Smithton Beach or FOAT Smithton) See map. Participants wishing to enter the fun race will need to float over to the start line.

THE RULES:

- Kayaks, canoes, SUP's (stand up paddleboards) and inflatables are eligible – absolutely no fuel/engines.
- TEAM entries may consist of up to 4 people. If more than one vessel is used, they must be connected together to qualify as one TEAM entry.
- Cannot exceed 9 feet in width
- Must be at least 16 years of age - Parental permission is required for waiver at registration for those ages 16-18
- All participants must wear a U.S. Coast Guard approved life vest
- No alcohol consumption is permitted.
- Each participant will be asked to sign a waiver form at on-site registration.

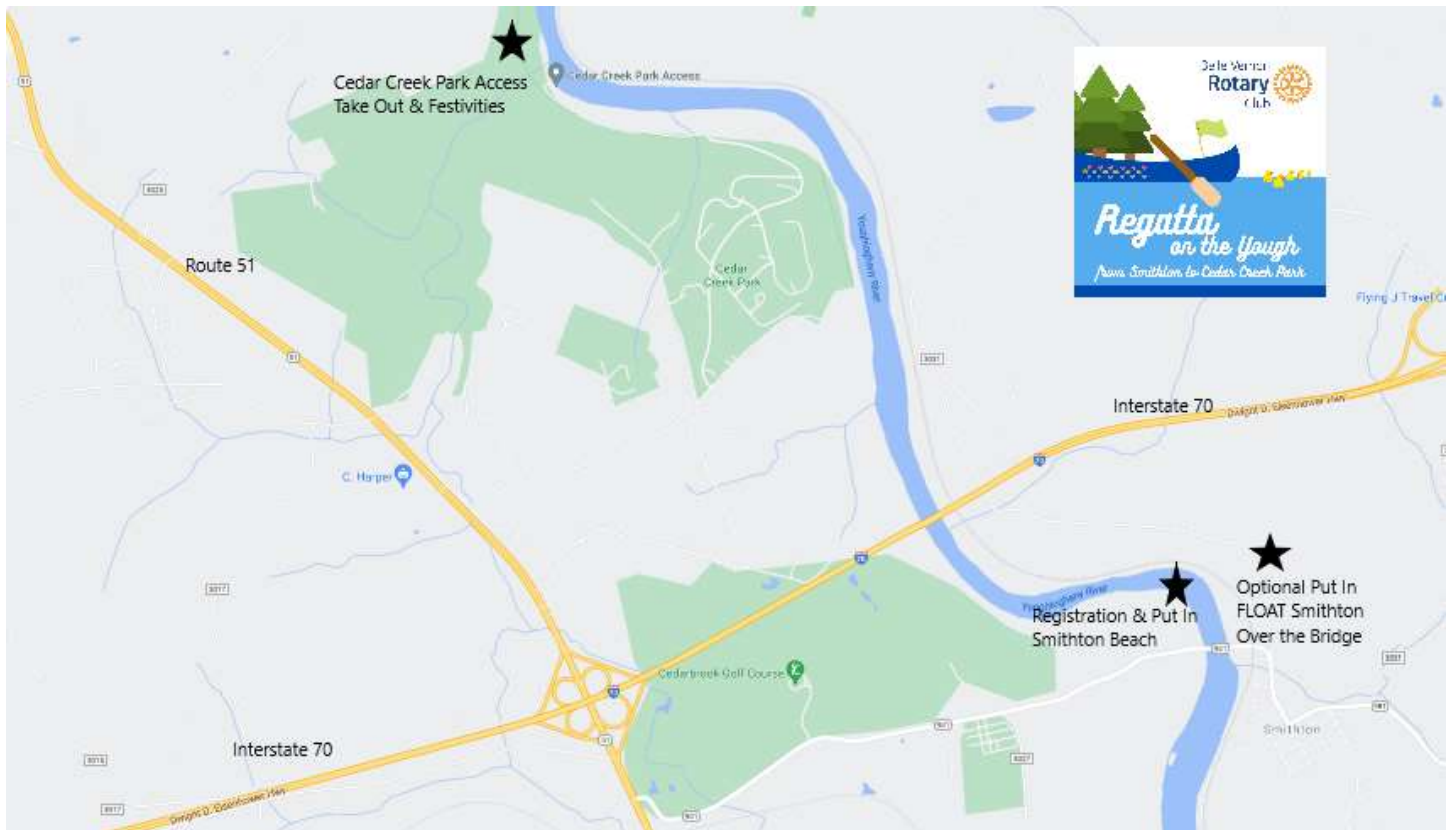

**DRIVING DIRECTIONS - Belle Vernon Rotary - Regatta on the Yough
2 Boat Launch/Put-In Sites and Cedar Creek Park Take-Out Celebration Site**

To Cedar Creek Park from Pittsburgh via Route 51 South

- Travel south; turn left at C. Harper Ford Traffic Light; turn left on Municipal Drive; drive 1 mile to park entrance; follow park road to boat take-out, river celebration area

To Cedar Creek Park from Washington via Route 70 East:

- Travel east; exit at Rt 51 North; turn right onto Concord Lane at Burger King Traffic Light; turn right on Municipal Drive; drive 1 mile to park entrance; follow park road to boat take-out, river celebration area

To Cedar Creek Park from Uniontown via Route 51 North:

- Travel north; immediately after crossing I70, turn right onto Concord Lane at Burger King Traffic Light; drive ¼ mile, turn right on Municipal Drive; travel 1 mile to park entrance; follow park road to boat take-out, river celebration area

To Cedar Creek Park from Greensburg via Route 70 West:

- Travel west; exit at Rt 51 North; turn right onto Concord Lane at Burger King Traffic Light; turn right on Municipal Drive; drive ¼ mile, turn right on Municipal Drive, drive 1 mile to park entrance; follow park road to boat take-out, river celebration area

To Put-In #1 Smithton Floats Boat Launch Site from all points N/S/E/W:

- From the intersection of Rt 51 and Interstate 70, drive ¼ mile South on Rt 51, turn left at Rt 981 traffic light, drive 2 miles, cross river bridge and railroad tracks, parking area immediately on the left (boat launch under river bridge)

To Put-In #2 Smithton Beach Boat Launch Site from all points N/S/E/W:

- From the intersection of Rt 51 and Interstate 70, drive ¼ mile South on Rt 51, turn left at Rt 981 traffic light, drive 2 miles, 30 feet before the bridge – turn left and down hill to the Smithton Beach Parking Area (boat launch near pavilion)
