Contrary to believe, the Ohio Park Districts are not funded by any taxpayer funding, unless a tax-levy has been secured. Preble County Park District would like to function and grow without a tax-levy. The "Friends" helps us to be able to receive grant monies and tax-deductible donations in support of our parks, as well as provide volunteer assistance.

I have attached a "Friends" membership form if you are interested in joining our effort to grow, protect and sustain our parks. It also lists the benefits of becoming a "Friend" to the Park District. Without further ado, let me tell you what we have been doing.

A "Friends" membership indicates that you believe in the importance of Parks to our community. We have two parks, the Garber Nature Center (9691 OH-503 North, Lewisburg, OH) and the Herbert and Patricia Wagers' Devil's Backbone Memorial Park, (1301 OH-725 West, Camden, OH).

The events of the past couple of years have reinforced the extreme importance of outdoor resources in our lives. In this regard, during the past three years much effort has gone into improving the quality of the experiences at both locations. At Garber, in addition to the regular maintenance and improvement of the trails, a Story Board has been installed providing additional interest for young families. We are also finishing up our "Natural Playground." A beautiful electronic sign in front of the Garber House, now catches the eye of all those who drive past. At The Wagers Park, we installed a required wildlife friendly fence and this park is now open to the public.
