

Transport Charter Information

What is a Transport Charter?:

- As a licensed hunting transporter we can provide transport and lodging to support your DIY hunt. We are also a licensed fishing charter, so we can provide those services as well.
- We are NOT a licensed guide or outfitter. This means we cannot provide any hunting gear or support in the field. We are not allowed to help process the game although we do provide you with all the equipment to safely preserve and transport your harvest.

Whats included:

- All food and lodging while onboard. You will need to let us know if there are any special dietary considerations that we need to be aware of.
- Fishing gear, tackle and bait.
- Meat processing equipment rental.
- Boxes for meat/fish and antlers.

What's not included:

- Travel to and from the boat. We can help arrange travel based on your itinerary. See travel below
 - Gratuity: 10-20 percent is customary depending on your level of satisfaction with your captain and crew.
 - Hunting/Fishing Licenses, Tags, Stamps and Permits.
 - Any deer/bear meat processing. Regulations prevent licensed transporters from providing any support "processing" wild game. We're not even allowed to cook it. But we do provide the equipment you need and freezer space to preserve the meat until you can get it home.
- I Alcohol is not provided, but is permitted. We are not licensed to sell alcohol as part of the charter, but there is a liquor store right here at the marina.

Travel:

- Travel to and from Prince of Wales from Ketchikan is not included, but we will help coordinate these flights based on your travel plans. Multiple options are available at the cost of about 160\$-250\$ each way.

Fishing Opportunities:

- Self guided Ocean fishing is prime during the summer fall. Salmon and halibut will be active. We provide you with a fully fitted fishing boat and all the gear.

- Kwalock River Coho Salmon is a tribal regulated fishery. This permit is not included but can be purchased here- <https://kwalockriverinn.com/purchase-river-permits/ols/categories/river-access-permits>

Tags/Licenses:

- Client is responsible for securing all licenses, tags, stamps, and permits required for your specific hunt.

Taxidermy:

- No taxidermy is available on POW.

What to Pack:

- Plan for rain. Lots of rain. Snow in the late fall. Layering is best. That's the Alaska way. But also keep in mind that we do have a full laundering facility on the boat, so you don't need to bring a lot of extras.

Software:

- OnX hunts- This is critical for understanding the area and unit boundary's.
- Navionics- This is used for all of your ocean fishing activities.
