Men's League Golf Rules

- 1. To be eligible for Men's Night you must play with at least one other player. All score cards must be signed and attested by 2 players.
- 2. All <u>FENCES</u> are out of bounds, 1 penalty stroke (You must replay from where the ball was originally hit from and NOT drop a ball where you think it went out of bounds)
- 3. Ball coming to rest on sprinklers, hoses, small trees, benches or mats, move 2 club lengths, no closer to the hole no penalty.
- 4. On hole #9 if you hit a ball into water hazard or trees take a 1 stroke penalty and take next shot from the drop zone. Drop Zone is directly in front of water hazard.

5. LOST BALL - BUSHES/TREES, and thick grass

For simplicity we have decided to treat the entire course as a lateral hazard, except for OB fences. If you lose a ball in the bushes/trees/thick grass, you may take a <u>1 stroke penalty</u> and play a new ball. THE BALL MUST BE DROPPED AT THE POINT OF ENTRY & NOT WHERE IT IS DEEMED LOST. See next page.

- Point of Entry can be determined by entry into trees, bush/ thick grass etc.
- If you hit your ball OUT OF BOUNDS, you must follow RULE # 2
- Fences on Hole #1, #2, #6, #7, #8 are considered OUT OF BOUNDS

6. UNPLAYABLE LIE

If ball is found and unplayable you have two options;

- Take a drop within two club lengths no closer to the hole − 1 stroke penalty
- Or Drop ball at point of entry into the hazard within two club lengths and no closer to the hole, 1 shot penalty.
- 7. No Gimmies
- 8. Anyone over 70 years of age may use the front tees for tee off if so desired.
- 9. Please ensure your score cards are turned into the Pro Shop beside money box. Last team playing should pick up proximity markers and return stakes to Pro Shop. If weekly dues are not paid or cards are not turned in your game will not be counted.
