Hello woodies

The major issue discussed at the last General meeting was the clubs Easter Exhibition for 2021. Due to the Covid pandemic restriction will apply. The Bendigo Council Major Events Team, in partnership with our club, will provide support and management for the event. Key points are:

- The event will be fully ticketed; therefore, visitors must register for an allocated time and pay online. Street traffic can be admitted if allocated numbers per hour has not reached capacity (50), and they will need to register.
- One entry and exit point.
- Security at each door.
- The CoGB will provide a QR Code and hard copy registration forms.
- Toilets will need to be cleaned every hour as well as all touch surfaces such as sales table.
- Sanitations stations set up at entry and exit points and throughout venue.
- Social distancing will need to be adhered to especially around the demonstration points.

There will another meeting with events team in the next week or so where several issues will be clarified. An update will be provided as soon as possible.

I understand that this year's Expo will be a vastly different one from previous years, but with the support from you, we can make it a successful one.

Unfortunately, the Cavendish event has been cancelled. Seymour and the UTurn event are still going ahead at this stage.
