It has been a busy time for many of us having just finished CraftAlive 23 at the Bendigo Showgrounds. This is a 4-day event which seems a little long to some but it proved very successful to us again albeit it seemed very quiet and slow through some periods. Club sales were up from last year and overall, with money generated from Raffle Sales, Toy Group Sales and Members Commissions the club made about \$1,200.00, which is fantastic. I would like to thank all the Raffle Ticket Sellers, Demonstrators, Sales Desk and Security people who contributed. I have added some photos below from CraftAlive.

Our next event and is only a few weeks away being the Australasian Sheep & Wool Show at the Bendigo Showgrounds from 14 to 16 July. This event is huge with our club sales exceeding wildest expectations each year.
