

# Terms Of Use Of Stonebridge Driving Range

- Only the provided range balls are to be used on the range.
- Removing golf balls or golf ball baskets from the site is strictly forbidden, anyone caught will be prosecuted and any credit removed/lost.
- Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Extra care must be taken when swinging golf clubs to safeguard injury, including:
  - Practice swings must be within the bay on the golf mat only
  - One person within a bay at any one time
  - It is advisable for customers to wear a golf glove
  - No trick/one handed shots or 'run ups' (Happy Gilmore) are permitted
  - Be mindful of structural posts, bay dividers, power tees and Trackman Range screens within the bay
- Any safety or security concerns are to be reported to the Pro Shop
- The entire facility is covered by CCTV which is monitored by the facility operator.
- Customers must not enter, retrieve, or hit balls from the grass or gravel area at the front of the range.
- The range operator cannot accept any liability for accidents or injury, due to neglect.
- Range users will be liable for the cost of any damages to property or injury caused by negligent use.
- All golf clubs hired must be returned to the golf reception. Management reserves the right to charge for any golf clubs lost or damaged.
- Users may not bring on to, nor consume on the premises, any food and drink that has not been legitimately purchased on the premises.
- Smoking and vaping are not permitted on the driving range.
- Foul language and any abuse to staff members or members of the public will not be tolerated. Any such behaviour will result in the person being banned from the site and use of all facilities. We further reserve the right to eject the whole party should behaviour be unacceptable.
- The Management cannot accept any responsibility for the loss of, or damage to, property belonging to any range customers, including all car park areas.
