Our dual-education model—integrating academic instruction, skills training, employment placement, and entrepreneurial development—is designed specifically to support underserved and underrepresented populations. This model is ready for immediate deployment in Washington, D.C.

The Edgar Hoover FBI Building presents an ideal location for this initiative, supported through collaboration with federal agencies to provide work-based learning opportunities, funding pathways, and a unified approach to economic mobility. Through IAM-USA and the IAM-USA Foundation, we can operationalize this partnership with efficiency, accountability, and measurable outcomes.

Mr. President, the opportunity to transform Washington, D.C. is both urgent and achievable. Since announcing my candidacy for Mayor, I have witnessed renewed hope across the District.
