Toxins Released Similar to 9/11

Burn pits release dozens of potentially harmful chemicals including hydrocarbons, volatile organic compounds, dioxins, and furans into the air, including the dioxin TCDD or "Agent Orange". Air samplings by the CDC at the Word Trade Center detect similar chemicals to those produced by burn pits.

CALL TO ACTION!

We ask for the same recognition extended to the WTC victims in regards to their illnesses as a result of exposure. Almost all of the diseases are similar to the diseases/symptoms self-reported and identified in the Burn Pits 360 Registry.
