

## VVA STATE COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP REPORT March 19, 2022

The above named members of Shawano VVA Chapter #206 assisted in the selection of the three (3) VVA State Council scholarship recipients of \$1,500 each for the 2022/2023 academic year.

Eleven (11) scholarship applications were received this year. I received approximately 15 inquiries from schools and individuals regarding the scholarship; including several that came past the deadline of February 19<sup>th</sup>.

I reviewed the applications for compliance requirements. Copies of the essays, planned majors and schools were sent to the committee for individual review and scoring. Ten (10) of the applicants were direct descendants of Vietnam Veterans, the remaining applicant's relative was an uncle.

The committee was given a deadline to read/review and score the applications before returning them to me for final tally. This year, for the first time, there was a tie for the  $3^{rd}$  award, with 2 receiving a score of 121. The Committee met before the Chapter's regular monthly meeting on March  $8^{th}$ . They reviewed the applicant's essays and voted to break the tie.
