- WHO:** The Arizona State USBC Senior Masters Tournament is open to all current AZ State USBC members who are 50 Years young as of **February 11, 2024**
- WHERE:** *Let It Roll Bowl 8925 N 12th St, Phoenix, AZ 85020 – (602) 944-4401*
- WHEN:** Qualifying: Sunday, February 11, 2024, **check in @ 8:00am**, bowl @ 9:00am (**ONE SQUAD ONLY**)
 Finals: Immediately following
- FORMAT:** This is a SCRATCH event and will be bowled on a challenge pattern. All participants will bowl 6 games of qualifying, moving to a different pair of lanes after each game. Upon conclusion of qualifying, the field will be cut to the top 4 (based on less than 23 entries), top 8 (based on 24-47 entries), and top 12 based on 48 entries or more. The 2022 champion will be part of the bracket and seeded based on their qualifying position (if outside of the cut line, will be the final seed in the bracket).
 Top 4 bracket: 1 vs 4, 2 vs 3 for the first round. Every round will be 2 games, total pin fall matches.
 Top 8 bracket: 1 vs 8, 2 vs 7, etc. for the first round. Every round will be 2 games, total pin fall matches.
 Top 12 bracket: Seeds 1-4 will receive a 1 round bye, and the first round will consist of seeds 5-12 (5 vs 12, 6 vs 11 etc). Every round will be 2 games, total pin fall matches.
 Tournament Manager reserves the right to adjust the format based on number of entries.
- ENTRY FEE:** The entry fee is \$125.00 (Expenses \$40.00, Prize Fee \$85.00). Excess lineage and expense money, if any, will be added to the prize fund. If space is available, **entries will be accepted up to 8:30 am. Cash only if entering the day of the tournament.**
- PRIZE FUND:** The prize fund will be returned 100%. Additional places will be paid on a minimum of 1:4 ratio. Prize money will be awarded immediately following completion of the tournament, unless contested. The Champion's award will be purchased from the tournament expense fund. Additional prize funds will be added from our sponsor **Bowl TV** based on the number of entries.
- GENERAL:** One-lane courtesy will be observed. USBC Tournament Rules and Regulations shall govern items not covered by these rules.
- BRACKETS:** Optional bracket and side pots may be available. (Will be determined based on number of early entries)
- DRESS CODE:** *USBC National Tournament Dress Code Applies (Slacks, Jeans, Butterfly Collar Shirts or Mock Collar Shirts). In addition, hemmed shorts and sponsor shirts are allowed. Women may wear skorts, skirts of at least mid-thigh length. Hats, caps and clothing with obscenities, holes, frays, tears, etc. are not permitted. Name shirts are encouraged. No T-shirts allowed. No electronic devices allowed in the bowler's area during competition. The Tournament Directors will have the final decision regarding acceptable attire.*

This tournament will be on a First-Come, First-Serve Basis. Walk-ins will be accepted if space is available. There will be a capacity limit of 150 bowlers.
