



Qualifications for **SUPERIOR PERFORMANCE** For
Arizona State USBC Association

1. Must be a former member of Arizona WBA or Arizona State BA or a former or present member of Arizona State United States Bowling Congress Association.
2. Must have been an AWBA/ASBA/Arizona State USBC member for a total of not less than 10 years (not necessary that they be consecutive years), unless injury or illness has shortened their career.
3. Must have been a WIBC/ABC/USBC member for a total of not less than 10 years (not necessary that they be consecutive years), unless injury or illness has shortened their career.
4. Must have bowled in not less than 10 AWBA/ASBA/Arizona State USBC Championship Tournaments, unless injury or illness has shortened their career.
5. Must have won State recognition in Arizona for their ability in bowling, and must also have won at least one (1) AWBA/ASBA/Arizona State USBC championship tournament,(i.e.) a member of a winning team, doubles, singles, or all events. Points will be given for winning first place only. Status on second and third place wins is for information and/or publication only.
6. Must have distinguished themselves in outstanding bowling performance over a period of years.
7. A posthumous award may be presented.
8. Nominations are **Due by June 1st each Season.**
