FORMAT: This is a SCRATCH event. All participants will bowl 6 games of qualifying, moving to a different pair of lanes after each game. Upon conclusion of qualifying, the field will be cut to the top 8 (based on less than 48 entries), and top 12 based on 48 entries or more. The 2025 champion will be part of the bracket and seeded based on their qualifying position (if outside of the cut line, will be the final seed in the bracket).

Top 8 bracket: 1 vs 8, 2 vs 7, etc. for the first round. Every round will be 2 games, total pin fall matches.

Top 12 bracket: Seeds 1-4 will receive a 1 round bye, and the first round will consist of seeds 5-12 (5 vs 12, 6 vs 11 etc). Every round will be 2 games, total pin fall matches.

ENTRY FEE: Please bring cash. This will need to be paid for onsite. The entry fee is \$125.00 (Expenses \$30.00, Prize Fee \$95.00). Excess lineage and expense money, if any, will be added to the prize fund.

PRIZE FUND: The prize fund will be returned 100% Additional places will be paid on a minimum of 1:4 ratio. Prize money will be awarded immediately following completion of the tournament, unless contested. The Champion's award will be purchased tournament expense fund.

GENERAL: One-lane courtesy will be observed. Entries will be accepted up to qualifying squad time. USBC Tournament Rules and Regulations shall govern items not covered by these rules. Capacity is limited to 95 bowlers between both Masters & Queens Tournaments per squad time.

BRACKETS: Optional bracket and side pots may be available

DRESS CODE: Dress Code Applies (Slacks, Jeans(neat and clean), Butterfly Collar Shirts or Mock Collar Shirts). In addition, hemmed shorts and sponsor shirts are allowed. Women may wear skorts and skirts of at least mid-thigh length. Hats, caps, and clothing with obscenities, holes, frays, tears, etc. are not permitted. Name shirts are encouraged. No electronic devices allowed in the bowler's area during competition. The Tournament Directors will make the final decision regarding acceptable attire.
