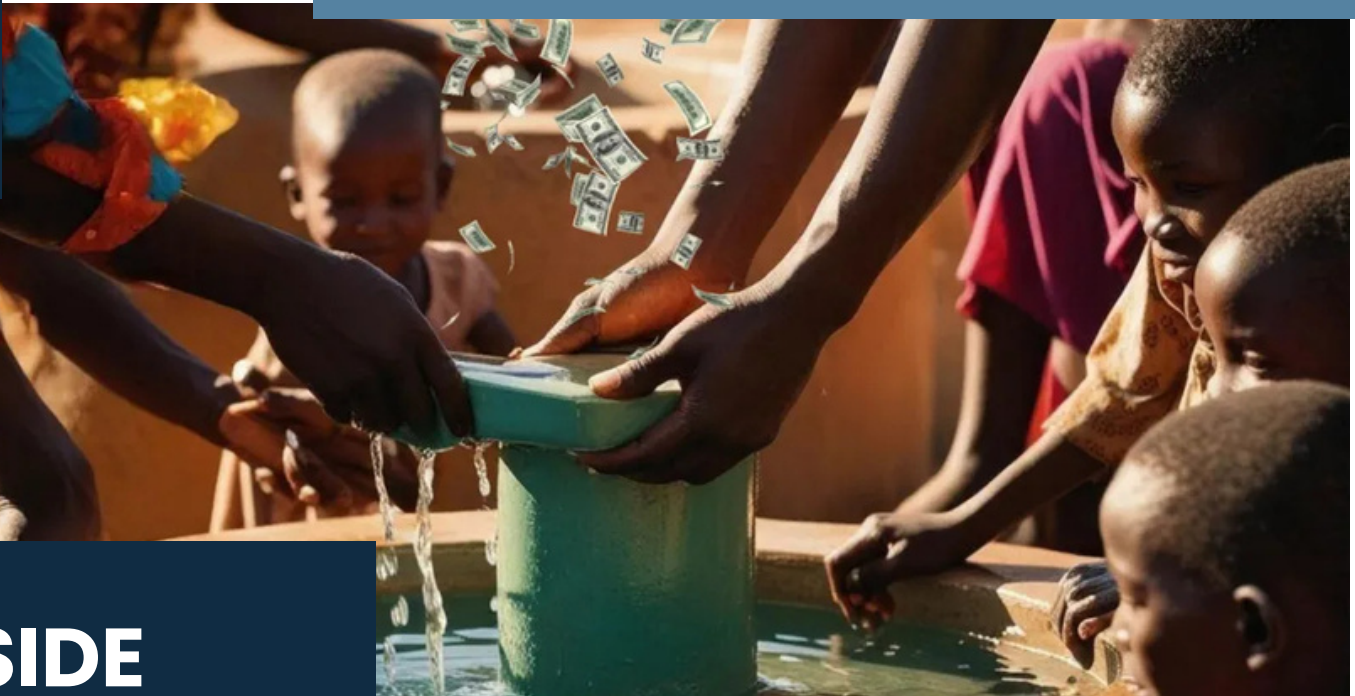

Completed Wells : Wells delivering Impact

Thanks to the generous support of donors, volunteers, and partners, we successfully completed four (4) water projects during the first half of this year - Tefape Well, Ogere Well, Ekiti Well, Burundi Well.

These wells are now providing reliable access to clean water for families who previously traveled long distances to obtain water from unsafe sources. Communities are experiencing improved health outcomes, reduced waterborne illnesses, and increased opportunities for children to attend school rather than spend hours collecting water.



Project Spotlight #1: Tefape Community Borehole Project

Location: Kaduna State, Nigeria **Completion Date:** April 2026

The Tefape Borehole Project's primary goal was to provide residents with reliable access to safe and clean drinking water, improving the health, and overall quality of life of the

community. Before the project, access to safe water was a significant challenge for residents. Through the installation of the borehole, community members now have

a dependable source of clean water for drinking and household use, reducing the risks associated with unsafe water sources and supporting better health outcomes.



Project Spotlight #2: Ogere, Hausa Community Borehole

Location: Ogun State, Nigeria Completion Date: June 2026

The Ogere well serves as a strategic outreach point to more than ten nearby Hausa and Fulani villages. This is especially significant because the Hausa and Fulani are among Africa's largest and least-reached groups. As their presence continues to grow across Southwest Nigeria, there is a unique opportunity and urgent call for the Church to engage these communities with both practical support and spiritual outreach.



Project Spotlight #3: Surulere Village Community Well

Location: Ekiti State, Nigeria Completion Date: April 2026



Surulere Village, located in Ekiti State and established in 1963, is home to more than 200 residents, most of whom are peasant farmers. The community is made up of both Christians and Muslims who live together peacefully. For many years, access to clean water was one of the village's greatest

challenges. Residents depended on a distant stream for water, despite concerns about its safety and sanitation. The limited water sources available could not adequately serve the growing population, often leading to conflicts among villagers competing to fetch water.

Hope Foundation responded to this critical need by providing a new community well. The well has significantly improved access to safe, clean water, reducing dependence on unsanitary sources and easing the burden on families. By addressing a vital need, the project has enhanced the health, well-being, and quality of life of the residents.

Project #4 (On the Horizon): Kinyinya Borehole , Burundi

Kinyinya Zone is home to an estimated population of approximately 3,000 residents. The newly completed well, which is awaiting official commissioning, is expected to provide direct access to clean water for more than 2,000 people daily, while also benefiting surrounding households and farms.

Pending & Upcoming Projects

We continue to expand our impact through several pending and upcoming water projects currently in the pipeline. We have a total of five (5) projects at various stages of execution, one of which is awaiting final evaluation and approval. Several of the projects have already progressed into the initial assessment and planning phases, where community needs are being evaluated, site visits are being conducted, and project requirements are being finalized. These upcoming wells are located in Togo, Zimbabwe and Nigeria.
