NOTICE OF MEETING TO VOTE ON TAX RATE

A tax rate of \$0.046151 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Emergency Service District #2.

PROPOSED TAX RATE \$0.046151 per \$100
 NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE \$0.046151 per \$100
 VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE \$0.047847 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2020 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Emergency Service District #2 from the same properties in both the 2019 tax year and the 2020 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that Emergency Service District #2 may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Emergency Service District #2 is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2020 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 17, 2020 at 5:30 PM at The John Erwin Annex.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Emergency Service District #2 is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting Emergency Service District #2 of Emergency Service District #2 at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.

The 86th Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by Emergency Service District #2 last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by Emergency Service District #2 this year.
