On the 31 October 2023 before making a new Westminster Confession of Faith on behalf of Your Body in the British Isles, Commonwealth Nations and all other Nations of the World we came to ask for Your forgiveness. We now come again before You asking You to continue in building a “foundation of repentance” (Hebrews 6:1) so that You may cause us to build on foundations that are entirely as You would have them be.

We repent of having accepted uncritically everything written in the original Westminster Confession of Faith without having checked this against Your Word. We repent of having failed to correct things in this Confession of Faith that are inconsistent with the Word, or which (either by what is said or by what is left out) misrepresent who You are, how You act, and how You relate to Israel and the Jewish people.

We repent of the UK having re-issued the Westminster Confession to your Body on its 350<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 2009 with these issues unaddressed. We repent of having continued to build on faulty foundations.

Please forgive us for all we have done and failed to do that is displeasing to you. Please cleanse and purify your Body and make its foundations solid and true.

Father, we gratefully receive Your forgiveness for ourselves and on behalf of your Body in the British Isles and all other Nations where this confession was founded. With heartfelt gratitude we come now to make our own Confession of Faith, trusting that You will lead Your people into all truth in the days ahead.
