

HOW TO ORDER

If you have landed on this page, you are considering placing an order with us. You will need to call, text, or otherwise contact us to finalize it, but there will be some questions that need answers that you will need to supply. So here goes...

GUNBELT SIZING: The easiest way is to use your present gunbelt. Put it on, snug it up where you normally wear it, note the hole that the tongue is in. Lay it out flat, then measure from the fold that holds the buckle, to the hole that it was in. That's it. The same thing works for a shotshell belt. If you don't have one, just measure around you at the belly button level, comfortably snug. Don't "fudge" the measurement. I rely on that number to be accurate and subsequently cut the belt for that measurement. The objective is to have the belt in the middle hole when you get it on and snugged up. See pics.

For holsters, a "drop" value is needed, plus a determination of a good toe angle for your guns. "Drop" is defined by a measurement of the distance between the tip of the gun grip and the top line of the belt, when fully in the holster. A pic of this is shown above. This value can vary considerably due to styles and preferences of different shooters. Toe angles go from 10 degrees which is about minimal, up to as much as 25 degrees which is average in the TwoSons style holsters. The "straight hang" holsters utilize 12-15 the best, as does the Ol Short Tom style. The drop can be determined by your old rig, or by having a friend hold a loose holster against your side, over a gunbelt where you wear it, then moving it up and down until it feels right to you. At that point measure the distance...now you've got it. The tilt out value is best determined by a conversation. We've done it a bunch.

We'll need to know your revolver make, model, and barrel length...ejector button style also.....caliber too if we are doing any bullet loop work for you.

For leather, we can do anything you want as decoration....smooth....fancy...in between...your call. It is important to remember that what you see on this site, they are just examples of what we have done in the past. Any rig can have any feature taken from any other rig.....colors, too.....including thread.
